Set-up times:

Friday (July 10, noon – until dark)

Saturday (July 11): beginning at 8:00am. **Vehicles must be off the field by 9:00am.** You can unload your car, move it, then come back to your area and set up.

To ensure a safe and efficient set-up process, the above time frames are available before the event opens to the public on Saturday. Vehicles must be clear of the area by 9:00 am Saturday when the park entrance road will be closed. You will not be able to enter/exit the park by vehicle during the event. Vehicles are permitted on-site to tear down at 4 pm Sunday.

We reserve the right to manage the entire space as needed and appreciate your understanding and complete cooperation. Thank you for your help!

Information & Tips:

- Cars/vehicles are allowed on the field to set up during designated times only. Please follow the signs for event parking.
