#### 1. Call to Order

Meeting called to order at 7:03 PM PST by President Ebeling.

### 2. Review of March 7, 2025 Minutes

The previous minutes were reviewed and approved without amendment. All prior action items were marked as resolved or continued under current agenda.

## 3. Inaugural Match Review & Final Report

- The club's first UKC-sanctioned match on May 17 was an overwhelming success.
- Paperwork has been submitted and acknowledged by UKC.
- Special thanks extended to the Match Committee, catering company, bakery, and ribbon supplier.
- Guest feedback praised the event's warmth, professionalism, and creativity.
- The General Fund proved sufficient, with surplus carried forward.

### 4. Membership & Social Media Report

- Although new memberships have slowed slightly following the pause in old marketing programs, the club continues to grow steadily.
- Facebook presence has surged, now averaging over 1,000,000 views every four weeks, with steady engagement growth.
- Since onboarding the **new marketing company**, CKCS United has seen improved post balance, including:
  - o Articles, memes, blog content
  - Contests and member features
  - Refreshed branding and targeted reach

**Action:** Continue quarterly analytics reports from marketing firm.

### 5. Legal Counsel Confirmed

- A law firm has officially been retained.
- Counsel is prepared to issue cease-and-desist letters regarding any harassment, defamation, or ongoing cyberbullying affecting CKCS United or its members.
- Legal representation will provide risk coverage, documentation review, and member protection support.

# 6. Executive Session Follow-up

- Private session outcomes resulted in the adoption of new programming and awareness initiatives
- Changes will be rolled out over the coming quarter with an emphasis on outreach and educational depth.

# 7. Grant Writing & Funding Increases

- CKCS newest member S.K. with grant writing experience has already submitted multiple grant applications, with promising responses expected.
- Donation activity from benefactors and supporters has **increased substantially**, giving the club greater flexibility in programming and project development.

## 8. International Breeding Agreement

- A UK-based breeder completed a U.S. visit, hosted by a CKCS United member.
- During a five-state tour, **formal contracts were signed** to introduce 20 health-tested, chocolate-line Cavaliers into the UK over the next 5 years.
- All Cavaliers are confirmed clear of DM, DECCS, EFS, and MCADD, have OFA CHIC
  and selected based on a/a and B/b or bb recessive genetic profiles. No KB genes are
  included.
- Australian members are also being contacted for contract fulfillment and future exchanges.

### 9. Project Roswell - Funded & In Motion

- Project Roswell received full financial approval; funds are now in escrow.
- Legal paperwork is being finalized by the retained attorney, with a 60–90 day window for completion.
- A media team and ad hoc committee have been assigned to secure coverage across various publications and platforms.

## 10. Moderation & Bullying Protocols

- The club has experienced a **noticeable increase in harassment and negative engagement** on social media.
- Board discussion yielded three general responses:
  - 1. Immediate deletion and blocking of hostile commenters
  - 2. Forwarding comments to legal for response
  - 3. Public rebuttals, when deemed strategic
- While approaches differ, the board is unified in refusing to tolerate member harassment.
- Screenshots are required for every hostile interaction.
- 14 admins have been assigned rotating moderation shifts for round-the-clock monitoring.

### 11. Stewardship & Judge Outreach Growth

- CKCS United now has:
  - 9 active UKC Stewards
  - 4 AKC Stewards (with CKCS United scholarship expansion approved for AKC steward applicants among members)
- UKC show attendance is averaging **7-9 shows per month** nationwide.
- A noticeable rise in historical color Cavaliers entering conformation has been observed.
- Mailings and breed education pamphlets for judges (UKC, AKC, IABCA) will begin rolling out in early 2026, divided by region.

## 12. Project DayBreak – Approved & Underway

- Following enthusiastic member support, **Project DayBreak** has been formally approved.
- Funds and a preliminary timeline have been allocated.
- A specialized task force is being formed. Due to the scope, a minimum of 50 volunteers will be required to launch fully.

## 13. Director Resignation (Hawaii)

- CKCS United accepted the resignation of the Hawaii Director after sustained bullying and defamation online.
- All harassing comments have been documented.
- The former director has requested that **no legal action be taken at this time on their behalf**.
- The board unanimously agreed to honor this request but remains open to supporting future action should new incidents arise.
