1. Acceptance to the UKC as the CKCS State Club & Match Considerations

- CKCS United has officially been accepted as a UKC club under the name CKCS State Club.
- Discussion on scheduling the first UKC-sanctioned match, considering logistics, location, and judge availability.
- Potential date options: March 29, April 19, May 16
- Need to finalize venue, confirm UKC requirements, and secure participation.
- Action Item: A.W to finalize match details and submit paperwork to UKC.

2. Update on New Memberships & Discontinuation of Incentive Gifts

- Membership numbers have continued to grow, strengthening CKCS United's reach and influence.
- Due to sustainability concerns, the club will be discontinuing incentive gifts for new members moving forward.
- Instead, the focus will shift to **enhancing membership benefits** such as additional educational resources, mentorship opportunities, and exclusive webinars.
- Action Item: Membership Committee to update the website and member communications accordingly.

3. Plans for UKC Attendance at Pivotal Shows

- Discussion on key UKC shows where CKCS State Club should have a strong presence in 2025.
- Shows of strategic importance include:
 - UKC Premier Nationals June 11-15, 2025 Kalamazoo MI
 - Classics
 - Midwest February 28 March 2, 2025 Richmond IN

- Southern May 2-4, 2025 Batesville MS
- Western August 1-3, 2025 Longview WA
- Eastern October 31- November 2, 2025 Lebanon PA
- Total Dog Invitational November 13-15, 2025 Lexington KY
- Need to determine who will be attending each event and how the club can best support members who are competing.
- Possibility of a booth at events.
- Action Item: Events Committee to coordinate club representation at these shows.

4. Juniors Scholarship Program

- Proposal to establish a Juniors Scholarship Program to support young handlers interested in UKC and CKCS competitions.
- Discussion on funding sources, eligibility criteria, and award amounts.
- Ideas for raising funds: raffles, sponsorships, dedicated donation drives.
- Need to establish a selection committee and an application process.
- Action Item: Scholarship Committee to draft guidelines and present at the next meeting.

5. IABCA Updates & Member Participation

- Review of recent member participation in IABCA events and successes in the ring.
- Discussion on whether CKCS United should continue actively encouraging IABCA participation or shift focus entirely to UKC.
- Some members still wish to utilize IABCA for international titles, but there is increasing preference for UKC's structure and credibility.
- Action Item: Members to provide input on future IABCA involvement; results to be discussed in the next meeting.
