



General

- 1) Irondog MX has the right to modify or expand these rules and regulations. Decisions of the judges of the contest are final.
- 2) Irondog MX is not responsible for theft or damage to equipment or property of contestants.
- 3) The Team Coordinator of each team will be held responsible for the conduct of its members and any persons who are or have been in his/her space.
- 4) Excessively loud amplified music, horns or public-address systems are prohibited.
- 5) Excessive use of alcoholic beverages or consumption of alcoholic beverages in violation of the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Code by a member of a team or person in the contestant's space could be grounds for disqualification and eviction from the contest/grounds. No alcoholic beverages are permitted for anyone under the age of 21.
- 6) Dogs must always be kept on a leash while on the premises.
- 7) Entry fee for competition is \$150 per team, fajita jackpot and margarita contest is separate. Entry fees and camping fees will be paid upon entering the facility.

Check-In

- 1) Please check in at the front gate when you arrive on site. Teams may set up between 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. on Friday, May 3rd and 6:00 a.m. – 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 4th. Meat will be inspected at check-in.
- 2) Chief Cook meeting will be held at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 4th at the Shop. Teams will receive their containers at the Chef's meeting.
- 3) Each team will have a space of approximately 40x40. There are limited spaces for electricity. These spaces are first come, first served and are \$50 per night. Generators will be permitted. Dry camping is allowed, each site is \$15 per night.

Cooking and Judging

Meat may not be pre-seasoned, marinated, or pre-cooked. Meat will be inspected at check-in. Each team can check-in up to (2) briskets.

- 1) Fires must be wood or wood substance No electric or gas fires allowed.
- 2) Holes or dug pits are not permitted. Heat shields must be provided for cookers capable of damaging the surface of the contest area. Each team must bring a fire extinguisher.
- 3) Contestants must supply all needed equipment and supplies.
- 4) No garnish, no sauce and no glaze is allowed in the tray or on the meat at turn in time. Sauce can be used during cooking.
- 5) Judging will be as follows:

Chicken	11:00 a.m.
Pork	12:00 p.m.
Ribs	1:00 p.m.
Brisket	2:00 p.m.
- 6) Results will be announced at approximately 4:00 p.m.

Optional – Jackpot Competition

- 1) Fajita jackpot competition and margarita contest will be held on Friday, May 3rd. This competition is optional.
- 2) Entry fee is \$25 per contest and only one entry per team is allowed.
- 3) Please turn your entry in at the Shop. Entries may be turned in beginning at 7:50 p.m. and no later than 8:00 p.m.
- 4) Prize money will be based on the number of entries and paid as follows:
 - 1st – 50% of entry fees
 - 2nd – 30% of entry fees
 - 3rd – 20% of entry fees
- 5) Results will be announced at approximately 9:00 p.m. at the Shop.

Move Out

- 1) Contest area must be cleared out by 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 5th.
- 2) A dumpster is located at the entrance to the facility to deposit trash in on your way out.
- 3) All cook sites must be cleaned before leaving. Absolutely no ashes, food or trash can be left at the cook site.
