

WHY SINGAPORE?


Singapore is known as one of the world's leading banking and wealth management centres, and a fast-growing cultural hub in Asia. Its ideal location, superb infrastructure, bilingual business environment, and work efficiency facilitate the movement of people and goods transported throughout Asia and beyond.

As of mid–June 2023, Singapore's population was estimated at over 6 million, including 4,498 individuals classified as ultra–high–net–worth individuals (UHNWIs), according to The Wealth Report published by Knight Frank in 2022. The number of UHNWIs rose by 6.9% from 2021 and is expected to grow by 17.7% to around 5,300 individuals between 2022 and 2027. Art and luxury lifestyle products are ranked as one of the top 5 investments amongst Singaporeans, with art ranked first, followed by classic cars (ranked second), jewellery (ranked third), and watches (ranked fifth) in 2022.

Singapore has a vibrant arts scene, home to a diverse range of up-and-coming and established local and international galleries, art institutions, and artists showcasing a wide breadth of works and fascinating year-round programmes. These organizations form a strong and healthy arts ecosystem bringing quality arts experiences and education to the public in Singapore and abroad, making the arts accessible to everyone.

The Singapore government is very supportive of the arts, with the National Arts Council (NAC) advocating for the value of the arts in society through strategic partnerships with key stakeholders, as well as providing artists and art groups with support to present insightful arts programmes to connect people together while bridging community in different segments and demographics and reinforcing social networks.

In addition, the NAC supports exploring and adopting new technologies in the arts, encouraging artists to continually learn, innovate, and collaborate in their artistic practices. The use of technology in contemporary artistic practices has paved the way to exciting new avenues of art, such as digital animated art and NFTs (Non-fungible Tokens), etc. – transforming art from a purely visual experience to an immersive one.


