Nevada CCW instruction is approved by the Nevada Sheriffs and Chiefs Association (NVSCA), in accordance with NRS 202.3657. The Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department makes the final determination relating to the issue of a CCW Permit. Completing this course is not a guarantee that the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department will issue you a CCW Permit.

The 8-Hour Pro Tek Defense Consulting CCW permit instruction course will be held at one of our designated locations throughout Nevada. Participants must pass a written exam and qualify on the range in order to successfully complete the course. The 8-Hour Pro Tek Defense Consulting CCW permit instruction course is a one-day course.

The 8-Hour Pro Tek Defense Consulting CCW permit instruction course fee is \$55.00+\$15 Range Fees. This includes all materials, range time, and targets.

The 4-Hour Pro Tek Defense Consulting CCW permit instruction renewal course fee is \$50.00+\$15 Range Fees. This includes all materials, range time, and targets.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

It shall be the responsibility of the applicant to familiarize himself/herself with the provision of the Statutes, Ordinances, Rules and Regulations pertaining to the privilege of carrying a concealed firearm, and in particular with the provisions of Sections 200.120, 200.130, 200.160, 200.200, 202.253, 202.257, 202.265, 202.280, 202.285, 202.290, 202.300, 202.320, 202.350, 202.360 and 202.3653 to 202.3677, inclusive of the Nevada Revised Statutes; any applicable local ordinances; Federal Law: Title 18 U.S. Code, Section 922 (d)(5), (g)(1-9), (n), and (y)(2); 27 CFR 478.11 and 478.32(a)(5)

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CONCEALED CARRY WEAPONS CHECKLIST

Pro Tek Defense Consulting CCW Permit Guidelines:

Any person who meets the following criteria may apply to the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department for a concealed firearm permit:

- If you are a Nevada resident, you must be a resident of Clark County.
- An out-of-state resident who received firearms training in Clark County.
- 21 years of age or older or 18 years of age or older with active military or honorable discharge.
- Must be able to lawfully possess a firearm.
- Successfully completes an approved firearms course taught by a certified Nevada CCW instructor inside the state of Nevada (paid for by applicant).

Pays the appropriate fees online.

You are ineligible to obtain a CCW if:

- You are under 21 years of age (excluding military exemption).
- You do not provide the required documentation to demonstrate competence with a firearm.
- You are a fugitive from justice.
- You have been judicially declared mentally incompetent or insane.
- You have been admitted to a mental health facility within the last 5 years.
- You have habitually used intoxicating liquor or a controlled substance to the extent that your normal faculties are impaired, including DUI convictions within five previous years and Medical Marijuana Patients.
- You have been convicted of a crime involving the use, or threatened use of force or violence, including misdemeanor convictions, within the last three (3) years.
- You have been convicted of a felony.
- You have been convicted of a crime involving domestic violence or stalking, or you are currently subject to a restraining order or other order of protection against violence.
- You are currently on parole or probation.
- You have been, within the preceding five (5) years, subject to any requirements imposed by a court as a condition to:
 - Withholding the entry of judgment for your conviction of a felony, or
 - Suspension of your sentence for the conviction of a felony, or
 - Indictment by a Grand Jury.
- You have made a false statement on any application.
- You were dishonorably discharged from the Armed Forces.
- You are not lawfully admitted into or are no longer lawfully within the United States.
- You are prohibited from possessing a firearm under state and federal law, and/or county ordinance.

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DESCRIPTION:

Understand and demonstrate adequate knowledge of handgun safety and civil and penal liability laws to legally carry handguns in the State of Nevada.

EXPECTATIONS AND GOALS:

- Understand and demonstrate adequate knowledge of handgun safety, handling, and handgun storage.
- Understand and demonstrate adequate knowledge of techniques and equipment used to safely carry weapons, retain control of weapons and avoid unwarranted detection of weapons.
- Understand and demonstrate adequate knowledge of Nevada Penal Code sections relating to firearms and sections dealing with the permissible use of a firearm.
- Understand and demonstrate adequate knowledge of Nevada and Federal Firearms Statutes, including knowledge of where firearms are prohibited and the transportation of firearms.
