Cheng Chang estate/accounts to be closed out soon The Parsonage is currently not being rented. We will



#### Easter Vigil Service, Saturday Evening, 7:45, April 8, AD 2023 at Antioch Lutheran Church, Dallas

All Lutherans of Gaston and surrounding counties (Lutherans of the NALC, ELCA, LC-MS) and other churches (Methodists, Presbyterians, Baptists, and others, *all*) are invited to Antioch Lutheran Church (330 Old NC 277 Loop Road, Dallas) for a celebration of the ancient "Vigil of Easter," the night before Easter Sunday morning.

The origins of this service began in the 1st century, pre-dating by several centuries the "Easter Sunrise" service.

The focus of this service will be the "new fire," the "exultet" praise for the Easter Candle (representing "the Light of Christ"), Old Testament readings, and a remembrance of our common baptism. Communion will *not* be celebrated, saving that festival for the following day in our own churches.

This service is part of the series of Holy (Maundy) Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Sunday, and is expected to last slightly more than an hour.




#### Death doesn't win



In the final hours of 2021, a wildfire near Boulder, Colorado, destroyed 1,000 homes, including one belonging to Pastor Bill Stephens. His family, out of town at the time, lost all their possessions. After months of feeling buried in debris, insurance paperwork and mourning, Stephens decided that Easter 2022 would mark a fresh start.

During worship that morning, the pastor shared a photo of vibrant daffodils emerging on his charred property. Burned remnants were visible in the background, just as Easter's backdrop includes the pain and death of Good Friday. But the empty tomb in Easter's foreground means death won't win, reminded Stephens. Even when earthly life "isn't all daffodils," we have hope and eternal life through Jesus.

Easter reveals that God will "give us the joy, and it's going to be in the heart of pain that we go through as well," added the pastor. "And that just makes me draw closer to God."
