WHAT DOES THE COISTE DO?

1. Fundraising

As everyone knows there is a significant gap between the funds received from the Department of Education and the costs of running the school, therefore one of the primary roles of the Coiste is **school fundraising**.

Previous fundraising activities have included; School disco; School cd; Cookery demonstration; Carol Singing collection; Christmas Show; Easter Raffle; Cake Sales; Uniform Sales; Coffee mornings, etc.

The money raised is wholly invested in the school and last year this was used to purchase, new computers, new science and maths equipment, for the benefit of all pupils.

We are always on the look-out for new fundraising activities and every idea is given due consideration, from the point of view of fundraising potential, capital and time investment and any potential financial loss to the school.

2. Facilitating School Activities

But it's not all about fundraising, the second key role is **facilitating school activities**, including School Open Day; First Holy Communion Reception and the Rang a Sé graduation Reception.

Fundraising and facilitating can take the form of making tea and sandwiches; selling cakes; or shaking collection buckets
