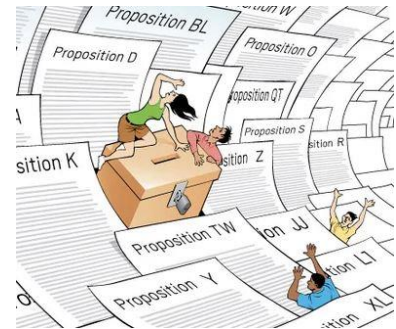




California's November ballot:
