## Studies Show That Few People Actually Fight With Family Over Politics on Thanksgiving

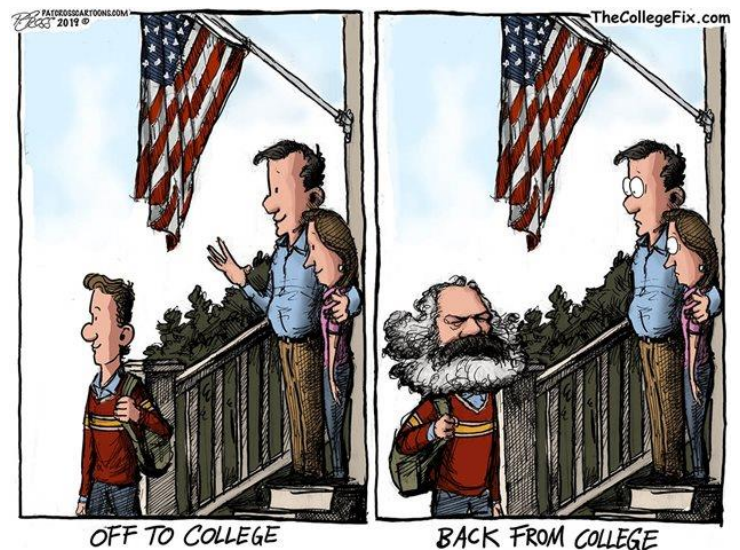

Since President Trump’s election in 2016, far-left activists have been pushing their progressive followers into disrupting Thanksgiving dinner by arguing with their conservative family members over the current political issues.

Last year, The New York Times profiled ways for liberals to argue with their conservative family members at the dinner table, an advice column quickly outdone by Eater asserting that people are morally obligated to debate racist Trump supporters before asking them to pass the gravy. Earlier this month, Joy Reid of MSNBC laid out detailed instructions on ways to discuss the current Democratic Party witch hunt known as the impeachment inquiry at the Thanksgiving table.

# WVRWF Celebrates Literacy Month

The Wine Cellar at the Westlake Village Inn was bustling on the evening of September 24<sup>th</sup> - with the who's who of amazing local Republican women – and a few men as well! It's no wonder it was a sold-out event – after all, it was tailor made for ANYONE who cares about children and is concerned with the direction public education is taking... and that's just about everyone with any sense, right? After all, they are the next generation!

We had two amazing speakers who led the charge in informing us about exactly what is going on in our local schools, specifically with regard to sex and gender education. The first was Sandy Everette.



Sandy is the lone conservative member on the CVUSD Board (Conejo Valley). Sandy detailed some the challenges she's faced with liberal board members who want to continue imposing a highly inappropriate sexual curriculum in grades as low as K-6. Sandy stated that "our job (as board members) is to reflect the values of the parents." She saw very quickly that was not happening. In fact, at a recent conference on the topic, an overwhelming majority of parents were opposed to the changes being made in public school with regard to sex education. Yet, the adverse curriculum continues to get approved. Sandy said "we're being told that sex ed 'needs to be progressive and comprehensive, starting at a young age so things aren't so shocking later.' She also stated that they continually perpetuate the false logic that 'the only way to prevent anti-bullying is by implementing this new curriculum.' Hmmm, how about we teach students about the 'golden rule' and/or about the no-tolerance for bullying rule? Go directly to the source of the behavior they are wishing to curtail instead of

pushing an inappropriate curriculum as a way to avoid it (ugh, liberal thinking). There are NO proven studies that even work! As Sandy put it, "they are literally using our children as an experiment!" Yes, they are putting 'agenda' over the welfare of our children, to be sure.

If it seems like we're over-reacting, here are a couple examples of books, Sandy shared, that have been approved in our local K-6 curriculum: "It's Perfectly Normal" for ages 10 and up. This book shows illustrations of people performing various sexual acts and positions. Another book, titled "Getting Through Your Teens" talks all about oral sex and anal sex as a way to remain "abstinent." - "This way you can avoid unwanted pregnancies." There is actually a chapter in the book titled "Do Not Choke." Ok, let's be honest, you probably laughed a little inside when you read that, but when you think of WHO exactly is being targeted with that kind of rhetoric, your giggle ought to quickly fade to disgust.

Another program Sandy informed us about was the Positive Prevention Plus Curriculum which targets 7<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> graders, teaching them "How to Terminate Pregnancy." The CTA (California Teachers Association) wants our teachers to tell the kids, if need be, they can get an abortion *during school hours* and their parents never need to know. Gasp!

There are also several books out currently being approved about normalizing transgender identity, and if Sandy (or anyone at all) is to voice a concern about teaching our elementary kids about these issues, they are being called "transphobic" and if one simply states the scientific facts of chromosomes determining sex/gender, they are being bullied and ostracized.

There was so much more valuable information that Sandy shared and if you'd like to learn more about how you can stand with Sandy and fight for our kids, she encouraged you to email her at [Sandyeverette.com](mailto:Sandyeverette.com). She will be running for re-election in 2020, so let's support her with our vote! Sandy concluded her talk by mentioning that our local publication "The Acorn" does NOT support her or other conservatives in our fight for kids and in fact, acts against us. She encouraged us to disengage from

The Acorn and instead subscribe to the “Citizens Journal” a local conservative publication.

The second speaker of the event was Rebecca Friedrichs. She is the founder of **For Kids & Country** and the author of **Standing Up To Goliath**. She was also a 28-year public school teacher who has led the fight against the divisive tactics, politics and corruption of teachers unions.



Rebecca and her husband Charles were seated next to me at our table, so I got the chance to talk to them as we were having dinner, and I immediately found them charming, and personable. The two of them met on eHarmony 13 years ago. Charles shared that he was also a teacher for many years in the music department at SDSU. When Rebecca was engaged in a conversation with someone else, I asked Charles “what’s something you can tell me about Rebecca”? He said, “well, she resigned from her teaching job after 28 years to devote herself full-time to this cause (of fighting against the corrupt teachers unions)... she is very passionate about it.” Then when Rebecca turned to us, I asked her if she grew up in a conservative home or what was it that influenced her conservative views? She said her Dad was in the Navy and raised her and her siblings to be very patriotic. She then paused for a moment and said, “you know, the most important thing my Dad instilled in us was a sense of standing up for the weak and innocent.” Shortly after that, Dale introduced her up at the podium and Rebecca had a lot to say.

She started off by complimenting Sandy Everett as being an educator who is very informed and aware, as unfortunately - so many are not. She then stated her personal goal (which ought to be our collective goal), “to salvage the Republic!” Rebecca said that it is absolutely being take down by teachers unions. They

(the unions) are deceiving, manipulating, and bullying teachers into delivering their political agendas. In fact, in the 1960’s the NEA (National Education Association) began to take more control of the PTA and now the PTA are *not even allowed* to oppose the NEA! Rebecca said the head of the NEA was recently quoted as saying “we use the PTA as a front.” She encouraged anyone involved in the PTA to reconsider, as the dues go directly to the unions. She said it’s far better to re-organize as a PTO (Parent Teacher Organization) because they are independent of any national affiliations or unions.

When trying to emphasize the massive threat the unions are to schools and the Republic at large, Rebecca cited George Soros and said, “Soros is piddly in comparison to the government unions!” She said Antifa, the Women’s March, Black Lives Matter, and Marching to Abolish ICE (and fight for sanctuary states) ALL began by the teacher’s unions. This gives us an idea of just how powerful and influential (and wrong!) the unions are.



For the second half of her talk, Rebecca further bolstered Sandy Everette’s points by focusing on sex ed in public schools. She said what’s going on is tantamount to “child sexual abuse.” Pushed by the Teacher’s Union, ACLU, and GLSEN, teachers were told to make the new curriculum “fun.” So, one teacher came up with a game called “condom relay race.” Yes, you read that correctly: condom. relay. race. This was to teach teenagers how to correctly put a condom on a life-size penis (dildo). They would get into two separate lines and at “go!” a student from each

line would attempt to put it on and if they didn't do it exactly correct, they would have to go to the end of the line and try again. I shudder to think of what the "winners" received! Teachers were told by the unions "If you don't agree to implement these 'lessons' we will bring in experts from Planned Parenthood to do it."

Public Education has come a LONG way ('she said' with eyes open wide and no smile). Rebecca pointed out that the original 'goals' for public education (when this country began) was 1. Education (reading, writing, and arithmetic) and 2. Morality (specifically with regards to what the bible says). It seems that number 2 has been tossed on its head and now there really is no such thing. Anything goes. 'Whatever makes YOU feel good – do it, and we shan't make any judgement.' Right and wrong are now purely subjective and relative. Actually, that's not totally accurate. The way public education and culture are currently going, it now appears that just about any morality to be found in the bible is what is actually "wrong." And, if you happened to be a Judeo-Christian believer, that translates into 'God is wrong.'

Rebecca wanted to be clear that it is NOT the teachers who are all a bunch of leftists. "That is a lie we've bought. Studies show that most teachers actually lean conservative. It is the unions who are all leftist. The teachers are just bullied into promoting their political agenda."

Because Rebecca saw what the unions were doing when she was a teacher herself, after 28 years, she could no longer idly sit by and watch them systematically destroy the public education system and the Republic itself. So, to make a long story short (you can read the more detailed version in her book "Standing Up To Goliath"), she ended up suing the California Teachers Association (CTA) in 2016 and the case went all the way to the U.S. Supreme Court! It ended in a 4-4 tie after Justice Antonin Scalia had just passed away. No doubt he would have been the vote that would have given Rebecca and her colleagues victory. And speaking of Justice Scalia, Rebecca said she was asked by a few people, "do you

think the unions may have killed him?" She didn't necessarily believe that, but just the fact that several people *asked* her that question proved to her just how intimidating, scary, and evil the unions can be.

Rebecca's husband Charles once said to her, "the unions treat teachers like mushrooms. They are kept in the dark and fed manure." The message is clear: teachers need to get out of teachers unions! But before they can feel remotely willing to do so, they need support. So, Rebecca's "For Kids & Country" sponsors a program called "Adopt A Teacher." It basically tells us all how we can do that: We find a teacher and follow the six E's: Embrace, Educate, Enlighten, Empathize, Encourage, and Empower

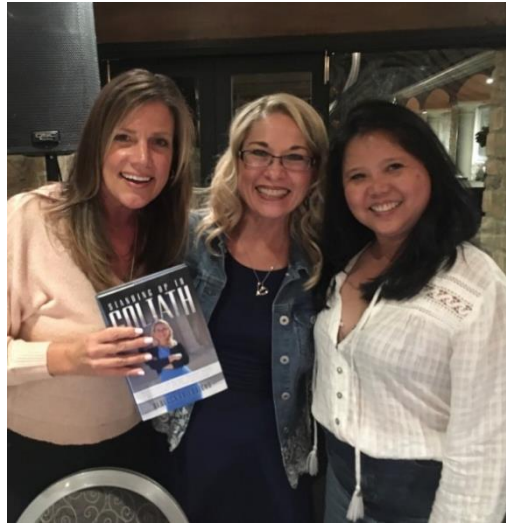
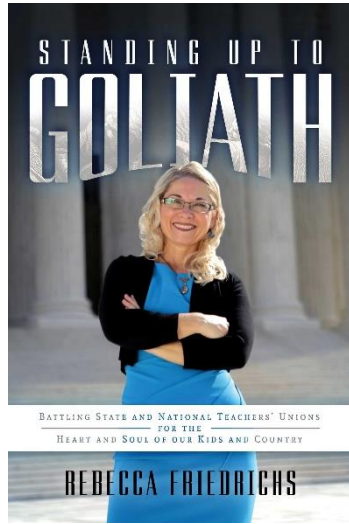


them. This way, they don't feel like they're alone. Someone is in their corner as an advocate. Will you consider this? Go to the For Kids & Country website and learn more.

Rebecca concluded her talk by glorifying God. She said, "I've been asked countless times how I found the courage to fight. The short answer is: God. At first, I was afraid to be rejected but then God led me to the "Widow's Might" in the New Testament. If you're unfamiliar with that scriptural proverb, the basic 'moral to the story' is that with persistence and faith, there is hope that even amid systemic injustice, justice may be done. She said she didn't know how much persistence she could have, but that God spoke to her heart and simply said, "Give me what you got!" And that's exactly what Rebecca Friedrichs did. Her landmark case set the groundwork for a more recent one (Janus v. AFSCME) in 2017 which won 5-4, and now people are no longer forced to pay union dues. Of course, the unions are looking to overturn this, but for now it's a step in the right direction. Thank you, Rebecca, for 'giving it what you got.'

**Important footnote:** September was literary month. At our event, donations were accepted for the Mamie Eisenhower Literacy Program and to support library selections in the Conejo Valley Title One Schools. Just about everyone contributed something in the little red

envelope that was given out to each attendee. WVRWF are proud supporters of literacy! (...except for the books that are focused on sexualizing our children, of course.)

## **Studies Show That Few People Actually Fight With Family Over Politics on Thanksgiving**

“In reality, very few Americans actually fight about politics on Thanksgiving,” notes Abraham Gutman of The Philadelphia Inquirer. “A 2017 HuffPost/YouGov survey found that only 3% of Americans said that they are ‘very likely,’ and 8% are “somewhat likely,” to get into a political argument with family members during Thanksgiving dinner. The result held at 3% for people who expected both Donald Trump and Hillary Clinton supporters to attend the dinner, though 20% said they are ‘somewhat likely’ to argue.”

So should politics erupt at the dinner table, etiquette expert Lizzie Post, co-president of the Emily Post Institute, laid out some guidelines to keep the night civil. “Not bringing it up is better,” Post told USA Today. “What you don’t want to do if you’re being open about it is to say, ‘Oh gosh, I can’t stand politics.’” “There’s nothing wrong with saying in a really polite and friendly way that ‘I hope you’ll understand, but I’ve actually decided to take a break from politics this holiday,’” Post continued. “Keep redirecting that conversation. You can always appreciate someone else’s interest in a topic without engaging in it.”
