

# THE AKIAK 8(A) ADVANTAGE

- Contracting Officers may now issue and award non-protestable, directed/sole-source contracts to Akiak Technology in any amount up to \$25M from civilian agencies and up to \$100M from DoD.
   FAR 6.302-5(b)(4), 19.813(a)(b), DFAR 206.303-1(a)
- Contracting Officers do not compete 8(a) requirements that exceed \$4.5M among 8(a) vendors before making a directed/sole-source award to us.

FAR 19.805-1(b)(2)

For acquisitions above the simplified acquisition threshold,
 Contracting Officers shall first consider the 8(a) program before considering small business set-asides.

FAR 19.800(d),19.203(c)
