

KRISTIN DIABLE

Kristin Diable has always written songs that find the extraordinary inside ordinary life.

A New Orleans songwriter with a voice as winding and resilient as the Mississippi River, Diable blends Southern storytelling with cinematic dream-pop textures, creating music that feels both timeless and unmistakably modern.

Her previous album *Create Your Own Mythology*, produced by Dave Cobb, earned critical praise from NPR, American Songwriter, and Southern Living. It also brought her to national stages including New Orleans Jazz Fest and Austin City Limits, and songs were featured on major network television shows such as Hawaii Five-0, MacGyver (CBS), Virgin River (Netflix), One Mississippi (Amazon).

But the years that followed reshaped her life completely.

Motherhood transformed her priorities.

Her marriage became abusive.

Her brother was lost to the opioid epidemic.

A global pandemic reshaped the music industry.

The path forward required rebuilding her life from the ground up. For a long time, making another album felt impossible.

Impossible Things is the result of choosing to keep going anyway. It is the result of choosing art and creation as an antidote to the fractures of modern life.



Recorded at Dockside Studios in the swamps of south Louisiana with producer Ben Alleman, the album expands Diable's sound into a cinematic landscape where Southern Americana meets dream-pop shimmer and subtle electronic textures. The songs unfold slowly and deliberately, inviting listeners to sit down, take a breath, and tell the truth.

The result opens a new lane inside the roots tradition, where Americana stretches toward atmosphere, color, and possibility. Dream-pop Americana, if you will.

Written during years of upheaval and reinvention, the record explores loss, motherhood, healing, and the quiet miracles hidden inside daily life. Diable describes the process as a kind of spiritual jiu-jitsu, transforming hardship into grace and ache into architecture.

Where many records aim to impress, *Impossible Things* aims to companion.

It suggests that transcendence isn't waiting on the other side of life's struggles but living quietly inside them if we listen closely enough.

Because sometimes the most radical act is simply choosing to believe in impossible things.
