#### H. P. O. A. Board of Director's Meeting September 21, 2020

\*\*\*Provisional Minutes until approved October 19th, 2020\*\*\*

#### Meeting came to order at 7:00 PM.

**Board members present:** Joe Cuccio, President; Tom Taylor, Vice President/Treasurer, Barbara Dohm 2nd Vice President; Richard Rivers Corporate Secretary, Security and Gatehouse, James Perretto, 3<sup>rd</sup> Vice President, Building/Events. 22 members also present.

Richard asked the Board for a motion to approve the minutes from August 17th, 2020, and Jim P. 2nd the motion; vote 5-0 in favor.

#### President/Administration Report:

Joe mentioned the traffic light is being constructed after many years of letters and requests as they are placing sheathing on power lines. It has been held up by two small sink holes adjacent to the pole. We are possibly looking towards October before it is finished.

Joe has sent a letter requesting no right turn on red. It was stated by the Sheriff's office that it was driver's error causing many accidents at and near the entrance of The Heather. Cars have been clocked at approximately 72 mph coming south on Rt. 19. Drivers do not move into the merge lane available but dart out into the traffic thinking they have time as they proceed into the far left lane. Please use the merging lane and put safety first.

At the entrance many are coming in the wrong side. Slow down at the barrels and enter on the correct side to avoid more accidents. The light will be there and the barrels will be removed soon as the traffic light is completed.

We have heard many complaints due to the cancelling of our Events held prior and at Christmas time. It was a unanimous vote by the Board to cancel these events due to the Pandemic/COVID-19. It is for your safety to have one event outside at the grills and hold a BBQ for Veterans day. See Ruthie in the office and James Perretto will expand on this under events Games are conducted leaving the choice up to you whether to wear a mask or not and to distance yourself as you enjoy the different activities provided at the Club House.

Our cleaning service sanitizes the building and facilities every Wednesday. The tables are wiped down with Clorox sheets and the building is sanitized every week. Sanitizers are provided at the entrance of the Clubhouse. We use masks and social distancing as we meet at everyone's discretion.

The office remains open and we ask that you please respect using the half door for your protection and Ruthie's at a distance. We sanitize the door knobs and half door so everyone is protected.

The dues will not be raised but stay the same at \$22.00 expected by the 1st of the month. We remain in good condition financially and reserves are funded.

At our entrance the sign was damaged and blocks fell apart on the grassy area. This was fixed with ground up concrete behind the blocks so they will not move and will last permanently. We have a nice appearance with the gatehouse and clubhouse painted and trimmed. There will be flowering plants placed at the entrance to enhance and keep The Heather a great place to live. We have one of the safest communities in Hernando County per the Sheriff's Department and deputies are scheduled to keep it safe.

I am very pleased to work with this Board of Directors! We need resumes for those who would like to run for the Board and the cost for the ballots as the election comes up in 2021 is around \$1,500.00. If we go state appointed the dues will be much higher.

Our Board right now consists of Joe C. with the background of Banking, Tom Taylor a teacher with accounting, James Perretto and Richard Rivers Sheriff's/Detective backgrounds, Barbara Dohm, nursing and Wall Street. So turn in your resumes to be elected and we also need volunteers for the A&D Committee and Budget Committee.

#### Treasurer's Report:

Tom made a motion and Richard R. seconded to appoint a list of people for the Budget committee, some volunteered, others he
is placing on the list as follows:

Bud Brooks, Geraldine Lampton, Mr & Mrs. Parekh, Victoria Kobea, Beatrice Hall, Susan Paige, Sabina Thoman and Richard Mayer to meet October 6th, 2020 at 10:00 A.M. in the conference room. We will be discussing the proposed Budget for 2021 – 2022 and making changes throughout the discussion if necessary. Those chosen, if you want to be on the committee, please show up at the meeting. Nine were chosen but if you do not want to be on this committee then you can just not show up.

- The financials are in good shape. We are losing the rental of the building due to the COVID-19 and the church not renting the building each
  week.
- . The Account are not wrong just adjusted and updates to our software must be kept up with and reports cleaned up. toben

The late list is at the amount of \$6,500. Letters will go out to collect these delinquent dues. If you have possible problems with employment
and having difficulties paying your dues, call the office and we will work with you.

A&D Committee – We have a new volunteer – Geraldine Lampton She will be helping with all violations along with Tom. We need more volunteers for this committee and ask if you would help out so we can keep a clean and neat environment at The Heather. Complaints received for the address on Edinburgh as the Board voted on a certified letter to be sent to the owner of the property to begin fines of \$100 per day not to exceed \$1,000 accepted by the fine committee and the Board. Unless the debris is cleaned up and violations are rectified as they will have 14 days to follow the process of our Deed Restrictions. Tom T. read the letter to be sent to the owner of the property, not the renter. Joe C. made a motion and Jim P. 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. County Code enforcement has been called and the Sheriff's office has also been notified of offenses.

There are about 3 new complaints of high grass needing to be cut. We are sending letters to rectify these situations.

#### Security:

Numerous vehicles entering the exit ramp to St. Andrews Blvd. are causing a very dangerous condition. The Sheriff's Department is giving
special attention to this condition. Please be careful. The gatehouse is logging those not stopping at the Stop Sign. Please be careful!

#### **RV** Compound:

Overgrown trees at the RV Compound have been trimmed by 3 Seasons so no debris should be a problem.

#### Grounds:

- Palm trees were trimmed and made hurricane safe!
- Empty lot is a sink hole property, needs mowed and will be taken care of by 3 Seasons Landscaping company.
- Shrubbery to be replaced at the front entrance with flowering plants.

#### Lakes:

- New Branch Manager with Aquagenics will be managing the spraying of our Lakes and Ponds and were here on Sept. 16, 2020. They do
  look so much better with the rain and the sun not hitting the plants will help them to stop growing up through the water as well as the spray.
- There is a situation being handled from a build up creating a clog in the back of a residents yard into the Lake which causes a diversion of the water flow. A bid was given that was outrageously high so we have found a much more reasonable person to do the job.

#### **Building:**

- Building has been powered washed, chairs have been steam cleaned and the A/C filters were changed.
- The A/C contract has been renewed.

#### **Events/Activities:**

- The fall Community Yard Sale will be held on Saturday, November 7th, 2020 8am till 5pm.
- On Veterans day we have planned a BBQ, \$10 each with the sign-up sheet at the office before and by October 1st. Should it rain we will
  go inside with social distancing. Outside we plan to play Corn Toss, Horse Shoes and Tony T. has been volunteered to do the cooking.
- Name That Tune and the Christmas Parties are both cancelled.
- We are planning a Spring Fling for everyone to enjoy hoping by then the COVID-19 will be gone and things can get back to normal.
- Donations are welcomed as we are gather canned goods and unwrapped toys to be placed in the containers in the clubhouse for those less fortunate.

#### New/Old Business:

None

Meeting was adjourned by Joe Cuccio at 8:15 pm. Next meeting will be on Monday, October 19th, 2020 at 7P.M. at the Clubhouse.




