President's Corner

October is here and the hurricane season is drawing to a close. Once again we have been fortunate in avoiding the big storm.

Article VI, Section 4, J of our documents state: Each owner shall at his or her cost or expense, maintain the exterior of his premises in good condition and repair:

No lawn or landscaping or fence or hedge shall be permitted to become overgrown or unsightly or obnoxious in the sole reasonable judgement of the HPOA. In the event that any of the said conditions shall exist, the HPOA shall take reasonable action or actions to alleviate and change the obnoxious condition and may assess the owner of the lot a reasonable sum for any such remedial activity and the HPOA shall not be deemed guilty of a trespass in such event. Any charge levied but not paid shall become a lien to be collectible the same as other delinquent fees set forth herein.

Remember we have three opening for Board members (2 year seats). To run: Notify the HPOA office and submit a short statement of your intent. Nominations will close in December.

Our Board meetings are held on the third Monday of the month at 7:00 PM at the community center. All members are


