






HOLIDAY NOTICE Trash, Recycling and Yard Waste Collection

There will be NO trash, recycling or yard waste picked up on:

- Thanksgiving Day, Thursday, November 26, 2020
- Christmas Day, Friday, December 25, 2020
- New Year's Day, Friday, January 1, 2021.

Trash, Recycling and Yard Waste will be picked up on the next regularly scheduled service date as follows:

- Thanksgiving trash will be picked up on Monday, November 30, 2020 (double pickup)
- Thanksgiving recycling and yard waste will be picked up on Thursday, December 3, 2020 (double pickup)
- Christmas trash will be picked up on Tuesday, December 29, 2020 (double pickup)
- New Year's trash will be picked up on Tuesday, January 5, 2021 (double pickup)
- Christmas & New Year's recycling and yard waste will be picked up on Friday, January 8, 2021 (triple pickup)

What to expect on double and triple pick up days:

Due to the increased volume of trash and recycling following a holiday, Republic will be working extra hard to ensure that all customers are picked up. Please expect the following:

- Your trash or recycling may be picked up earlier or later than usual (Please set at the curb before 6am)
- · Extra trucks may be working in your neighborhood
- Trucks may run late into the evening beyond normal work hours
- Holiday trash and recycling pickup may be delayed; in this event, this will also delay normal trash and recycling pickups for the week. Any missed pickups will be completed the next business day.

<u>Drop Off Available:</u> All Hernando County Solid Waste facilities will be closed on the holidays; however, these facilities will be open during normal business hours the remainder of these weeks for residents wishing to dispose of excess trash, recycling or yard waste.

Holiday Schedule (No Service and Landfill is closed): Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, New Year's Day, Independence Day

Christmas tree disposal:

Live Christmas trees may be disposed of on your yard waste day if they are cut to less than four-foot lengths and cleaned of all Christmas decorations, including tinsel.

Artificial Christmas tree segments under 4 feet long, and any decorations thereon, may be disposed of as a free bulk item by calling to schedule pickup before January 31, 2021.

H. P. O. A. Board of Director's Meeting November 16th, 2020

Provisional Minutes until approved December 21st, 2020

Meeting came to order at 7:00 PM.

Board members present: Joe Cuccio, President; Tom Taylor, Vice President/Treasurer, Barbara Dohm 2nd Vice President; Richard Rivers Corporate Secretary, Security and Gatehouse, James Perretto, 3rd Vice President, Building/Events, 20 members also present.

Richard asked the Board for a motion to approve the minutes from October 19th, 2020, and Barbara Dohm. 2rd the motion; vote 5-0 in favor.

President/Administration Report:

Joe spoke of the last Board Meeting and the protocol for the meetings from here on out, There will be no one speaking while the Board is conducting business and a deputy will be in the building to remove anyone that speaks without having permission to do so. Residents will be given 3 minutes to ask a question and speak their piece with their concern(s).

The Board does not get paid, it's on a volunteer basis.

We appreciate those who are running for the Board and wish you luck as the election approaches. All who want to run, please hand in your resume at the office to be viewed by the Board.

The reason those of us are still on the Board is because no one was stepping up to run for the positions needed.

Tom and Joe have switched places to keep it running.

People must respect the Board meeting and know that if you run and win, you may be the one disrespected. This behavior will not be tolerated.

There is no money used to print the newsletter. The advertisements pay for our newsletter.

We want our Board meeting to be very informal, light and easy. There are only 2 meetings to say whatever you want, this is not the Meeting!

Three Seasons are to give a proposal to Ruthie at the office for flowers and shrubs for the Gatehouse area. This will come in soon so we can plant a nice arrangement for our entrance.

Dues pay for the landscaping, the ponds and lakes, the gatehouse employees and the Office administrator's salary.

Joe mentioned the traffic light being delayed because of the sink hole problem which has been repaired by Helicon at the South West corner with cement in a wire type basket needing 2 weeks to solidify to support the 50′ pole that goes over the highway..

I know you have to slow down at the barrels to enter going south on Route 19 and I've called to have them removed but the state chooses to have them there. Please be careful and enter on the correct side to avoid any accidents. The light will be there and the barrels will be removed as soon as the traffic light is completed. We are hoping by December 25th? Possibly our Christmas present.

Our cleaning service sanitizes the building and facilities every Tuesday. The tables are wiped down with Clorox sheets. Sanitizers are provided at the entrance of the Clubhouse. We use masks and social distancing as we meet at everyone's discretion.

The office remains open and we ask that you please respect using the half door for your protection and Ruthie's at a distance. We sanitize the door knobs and half door so everyone is protected. Please limit the amount of people in the office at one time honoring the COVID-19 guidelines. During the Holiday season please use the lock box for your dues if the office should be closed. Ruthie is at lunch from 12noon till 1 and there are errands to run so she may not be back at 1 p.m. Signs will always be posted for your convenience.

Treasurer's Report:

January payroll – Tom made a motion for a 9 cent raise for the employees per hour, Joe asked to make it 10 cents. It was agreed and Rich 2nd the motion. The end result will be \$8.65 per hour by Jan. 1nd.

Minimum wage was predicted to be raised to \$15.00 per hour as Congress votes on this adjustment.

The financials are in good shape.

The late list is \$1,200 less than last month and we will be sending letters to reduce the amount and collect past dues.

A&D Committee -

Political signs need to be taken down after the election is over and letters went out concerning this.

The only signs allowed are Real Estate as houses are up for sale.

Security:

The Gatehouse has noted cars going in the wrong way, Please be careful and slow down to depict the correct lane to enter The Heather. Helen retired from the gatehouse October 31st, 2020. We now have Rick working beginning Dec. 1st 2020. Brenda is the supervisor who will train him.

RV Compound:

There is a combination lock being placed on the gate by January 1st and it will be changed yearly.

Violation letters were sent out that may open up 3 spots for those on the waiting list.

You are responsible for your own spot.

Signs have been renewed for the lakes and for no soliciting.

Grounds:

The dead tree complaint from Heather Blvd has been taken down. No more than \$500.

Brick work at our entrance sign was damaged and is fixed around \$400.

Lakes:

Aquagenics will have a sit down meeting with Joe concerning the growth of an aggressive plant needing to be dealt with chemicals applied on an air boat.

As the water gets lower the sun causes the plants to grow, more water helps it to subside and grow slower.

Building:

Awnings are now installed at the clubhouse and gatehouse...

BBQ area has been cleaned and shuffle boards are repainted and striped, new park benches have replaced the old.

Corn Hole and Horse Shoes are available to play.

Events/Activities:

The fall Community Yard Sale held on Saturday, November 7th, 2020 8am till 3pm was very successful.

We will plan another one in the Spring March 6th, 2021.

Donations are welcomed as we gather canned goods and unwrapped toys to be placed in the containers in the clubhouse for those less fortunate. Please be generous.

New/Old Business:

Public spoke of concerns about loud music from vehicles in The Heather which was addressed.


