

## The WOBL Manifesto

**\$WOBL** is a community-powered meme coin built on Maui's legendary wobble — fun, fearless, and rug-free, wobbling to the moon one paw at a time.

Maui's journey began in Serbia, born into a family of show dogs. He arrived in the U.S. with his own passport and a flawless little bow — not for the show ring, but for a life where personality would matter far more than pedigree.

In June 2020, everything changed. I found him in the backyard, unable to move, his hind legs paralyzed from the waist down. It was the height of COVID, and I rushed him to the emergency vet, unable to follow him inside. The diagnosis was **Intervertebral Disc Disease (IVDD)**, and immediate spinal surgery was his only chance.

After surgery, the vet tested his hind legs. When they pressed his paws, his feet still responded. That tiny reflex meant hope — he could feel, and his body was still capable of movement. The vet explained that if his legs had hung limp, he would have been paralyzed forever.

So we worked. Most For two months, we took him to hydrotherapy sessions, each one ending the same: no improvement, but no giving up. Both the vet and the hydrotherapist told me he still had muscle memory because of that reflex. But that most dogs show signs of improvement within a few weeks of IVDD surgery and are standing/walking at this point. Then came the choice:

- Give him wheels, and he'd live a happy, full life — but never walk again.
- Keep working with him, knowing the outcome was uncertain.

With the help of friends, we held him up, worked his legs, and kept believing. Then, on **August 1, 2020**, two long months later, Maui stood on his own for the first time since surgery.

Walking was still beyond reach... until a yoga ball and a friend named Bob entered the picture. Something about that ball awakened a spark in him. Combined with hydrotherapy and his stubborn determination, Maui began taking his first steps — awkward, wobbly, but full of fight.

Five years on, Maui's path hasn't been without setbacks. There have been stretches when walking was impossible, days or weeks when his body needed rest. Yet today, he moves with a confident shuffle, a hop, and his unmistakable wobble — claiming more good days than bad.

And through it all, he still bows like a legend.
