- We have submitted an application for state funding of our Webster Heights water main project. This is still pending.
- We have a price from Drain Doctor to look into a possible inflow area; the quote does not exceed \$6,000. This work will proceed July 1st.

• We are updating the GIS with new information from Stan.

• The new plotter will cost between \$2,000 & \$2,500. Motion to proceed?
