Los Angeles Professor Releases Not-So-Typical Love Story The Greek Persuasion challenges the notion of one true love

Is there such a thing as one true love, a person's other half?

Los Angeles Valley College assistant professor Kimberly K. Robeson tackles this age-old question in her provocative debut novel *The Greek Persuasion* (She Writes Press, April 2019). Through the adventures of protagonist, Greek-American professor Thair Mylopoulos-Wright, the novel explores both the nuances of sexual orientation and complexity of mother-daughter relationships in a tale that is, at once, sensual and cerebral.

Consumed by a myth about Zeus, soul mates and a magic sword, Thair goes on a quest for wholeness and experiences several unexpected and exciting romantic relationships. While recounting her grandmother's youth in 1940s Egypt and her mother's in 1960s Greece, Thair gains appreciation for the influence of her family's matriarchs, but chooses to forge her own path beyond the traditional. Engaging in relationships with both men and women, Thair gains new insight into her quest for completion.

Novelist Kimberly K. Robeson takes readers on an emotional journey through exotic settings and complex desires that will leave readers turning pages well into the night. The author navigates the landscapes of a port city in Egypt, a tranquil Greek Island and its mainland, cities in the United States, as well as the complicated human heart.

Will Thair ever find the missing part of her that Zeus chopped off with his magic sword? Or is the concept of "The One" just a fairy tale that ultimately leaves us disappointed? Is completion something we all hold within ourselves?
