Tennessee Little Britches Rodeo Association has been created to be able to offer the talented kids ages 5-18 in our great state a chance to compete at a national level. According to RFDTV, each year thousands of kids travel the nation competing in local rodeos for a chance to qualify for Little Britches National Finals, now held at the Lazy E Arena in Guthrie, OK.

Tennessee Little Britches Rodeo Association, TNLBRA, will have approximately 110 competitors in the sanctioned divisions of Little Wrangler, Junior and Senior division for ages 5-18. Of course, none of this is possible without the continued support of parents, grandparents, friends and other family members who cheer on these talented athletes. Our spectators are expected to number 350+. These future rodeo stars and their families travel not only from Tennessee but also Alabama, Missouri, Kentucky, Illinois.
