Dear Co-Laborers in Christ,

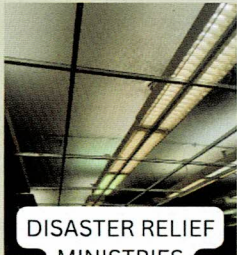
