RESIDENTIAL CARE

Each of Ebenezer's 9 homes operates as a family. The kitchen table is a gathering spot for meals, homework, games, and devotions. In order to build and maintain trusting and nurturing relationships, we employ house parents that live in the home and care for the children for 7 days before switching out with another group of house parents for the next 7 day shift. The Ebenezer family strives to teach the children how to relate to others, deal with the losses they have experienced that brought them into foster care, and to develop healthy coping skills to deal with life's challenges. Ebenezer gives each child the chance to be a child again, to build trust, let go of worries about their siblings, where their next meal is coming from, and to begin to see that there are good people in this world.

Ebenezer Christian children's Home is a long-term home for children in need of placement because they are unable to reside in their natural homes for various reasons. Upon opening the first home, Genesis Home in 1994, it became evident that there was a great need for quality homes for children. Our other homes include Faith Home (1997), Charity Home (2002), Hope Home (2007), Joe Severt Home (2012), The John Shepherd Home (2012), Grace Haven Home (2020), Caleb's Home (2025), and Esther's Home (2026). Within our nine residential homes we have the capacity to serve 70 children, ages birth to 21 years old. Ebenezer is blessed to have a chapel on our property called Living Grace Chapel (2000). This is a place to meet the spiritual needs of the children and staff. The chapel also serves as a place for groups to gather for singings and special events and services. Although it is unfortunate that a place like Ebenezer is needed, we are so thankful that God has chosen us to make a difference in the lives of children in need. Along with faithful friends and supporters like you, we are changing lives for the better.



ADOPTIONS

Adoption is to voluntarily accept a child into one's own family through legal means to raise and love as one's own child. Ebenezer adoptions are foster-to-adopt, meaning the children are in foster care and their first plan is reunification with birth families. When that is not possible, our families have the opportunity to adopt the child they have served. As of spring, 2025, we have been blessed to be a part of over 100 adoptions.

FOSTER FAMILIES



Ebenezer foster families care for children (birth-21 years) in their home when they have been removed from their families due to abuse, neglect, maltreatment, and/or abandonment. Foster families allow a child to experience a healthy, nurturing family atmosphere and to learn how a healthy family functions.

Ebenezer offers all the training and support needed to become licensed foster parents in North Carolina. Our licensing workers are knowledgeable regarding all the required applications and inspections and are there to guide potential foster families through the licensing process. Once licensed, foster families are assigned their own Ebenezer social worker who is an advocate for both the foster family and the foster child. As a part of this new experience many questions will arise. It is important to know that our foster families can count on the Ebenezer family for support. We are dedicated to the children and families we serve. We maintain this support throughout the foster care experience.
