It has been an incredible month of ministry. Our little flock seems to be in another season of growth. God has brought us quite a few first-time visitors throughout the month as well as some return visitors and some out-of-state visitors who come by when they are travelling through. One of the highlights of the month came on the final Sunday morning, when three first-time visitors walked in. Two of the men responded to the invitation. One was a believer and had questions about our church. The other, Corey, was under conviction throughout the service. Two of our men, John and Josh, were able to lead him to the Lord. He said, "I just feel so different. I feel like my toes are tingling." I know we're not saved by our feelings, but I thank God I have a salvation that I can feel.

The jail ministry continues to be a big part of our outreach. It is a combination preaching, teaching, evangelism, discipleship, and apologetics. Gideon, our son, told me that every Bible college student should have to spend six months with us to learn to defend and explain Bible truth. It is both a challenge and encouragement to hear their questions and to 'have to' depend on the Holy Spirit to give wisdom and understanding. There is no common ground. Often, no Bible knowledge at all. And just as often, if there is some knowledge it is incorrect. After a year, we are having more men and women reaching out outside the jail facility. Pray that we can get them into a good Bible-believing church.

The chaplain work continues to grow. Adding the Farmington Fire Department to this ministry has been exciting. It is a very different world from that of the Police Department – shifts, personnel, training, perceptions, responsibilities, etc. I am slowly getting to know the different crews. I was able to attend some training at the end of the month and was able to meet other city fire departments in our county. There is a huge need for chaplain work throughout the region/state. Pray for laborers!

The year is off to an amazing start through the first two months. The church is growing little by little. We continue discipleship with individuals and couples. There is a growing excitement not just to see visitors but to reach them with the Gospel. The family is doing well. Abigail and Gideon are a huge asset to the ministry and do so much (music, tech, outreach, etc.) while working full-time jobs. I love my family! Please keep us in your prayers.
