The chaplain and jail ministries continue to go well. There have been some great one-on-ones this month with inmates asking questions and truly searching for answers. Angela was able to lead one lady to the Lord at the end of the month. It was so exciting to hear her tell the story on our way home. Pray for the inmates and officers that God will give us continued favor and fruit for our labors. Because of our work in the city, a service organization, Just Serve, recognized me with an America250 Community Service Award. It was presented at our City Council meeting on the 16th. Many of the police officers and firemen came to support us.
