The chaplain work is also going well. I try to spend time every Tuesday at the Police and Fire Departments. God has opened the door to many good conversations. Pray that God will give me wisdom and favor in each encounter. Both departments deal with high stress situations and it can impact both the individual, the team, and their families.

Our family and little flock are still doing well. There has been a little lull in the number of visitors we were seeing. But that is normal as the summer begins and travel increases. As our little flock grows, the number of prayer requests and needs grows. There are many physical and spiritual needs among our people.
