We had **four men saved in August and one woman**. In one of our Sunday services in the latter part of August, I had a guard step in toward the end of the first service and ask me to be a little quieter. He said that I was 'too loud'. If he only knew the story of the Prodigal Son and the love and grace God reveals in that passage of Scripture, he would have wondered why I was so quiet.

The chaplain work continues to go well. It opened the door in August to minister to a family in need. Please pray for Jared and his family. We were able to provide some food and the Gospel. Also, keep all the officers and staff in your prayers. I continue to have some great conversations with the men and pray for open doors and hearts.

On the family front, we are pressing on. Abigail and Gideon are doing great with work and ministry. They are gearing up, with the rest of us, for another year of Power Hour. Angela and I are well.
