We've adopted him as our eighth child 😊.

The second week, we had three young men from Texas come out to help with John/Romans. It was such a tremendous boost to have Dylan, Jared, and Elijah for a few days. They worked in the rain on Tuesday, the snow on Wednesday, and the wind on Thursday, and were able to get to over 4,200 doors. Elijah (17) preached for us on Wednesday and did an outstanding job.

To close out the month, some precious friends from our home church, Phil and Kathy, came to visit for a few days. It was such a blessing to have them with us. We laughed and cried and rejoiced in the goodness of God and the precious times we shared serving Him. The Monday night they arrived, I had the privilege to preach the first night of a Mission Conference for Pastor Mullineaux, at Harvest Valley Baptist, in Riverton, Utah.

The Saturday before Resurrection Sunday, I had the opportunity to speak for about ten minutes on the Resurrection. It was a most interesting service, with an audience of 99% Mormon/LDS. God gave great liberty to speak and I pray that He will use the truth that was given to open hearts and minds to the truth of God's Word. The seed was sown.
