Franklin Castle (Tiedemann House)	Cleveland, Cuyahoga County	Victorian mansion with tales of hidden rooms, tragedies, and persistent apparitions.
Lake View Cemetery – Haserot Angel	Cleveland, Cuyahoga County	Famous weeping angel statue; reports of eerie vibes and unexplained phenomena nearby.
Cleveland Grays Armory	Cleveland, Cuyahoga County	19th-century armory; footsteps, shadow figures, and military-era echoes.
Playhouse Square – State & Connor Palace Theatres	Cleveland, Cuyahoga County	Historic theaters where staff note cold spots, whispers, and balcony specters.
The Arcade	Cleveland, Cuyahoga County	Gilded 1890s shopping arcade; after-hours footsteps and faint music reported.
Soldiers' & Sailors' Monument	Cleveland, Cuyahoga County	Civil War memorial; docents mention voices and movement when no visitors are present.
USS Cod Submarine	Cleveland, Cuyahoga County	WWII sub with knocks and voices after dark; residual sounds of service life.
Farnam Manor	Richfield, Summit County	Early 19th-century manor; legends of a girl named Emily and unusual EVPs.
Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens	Akron, Summit County	Country estate where staff recount subtle footsteps and a watchful presence.
Hower House	Akron, Summit County	Victorian mansion museum; piano notes and apparition by the staircase.
Akron Civic Theatre	Akron, Summit County	Moorish Revival theater; seats fold on their own and a playful balcony spirit.
Canal Fulton – St. Helena Trail & Crybaby Bridge	Canal Fulton, Stark County	Historic canal town with late-night cries and phantom footsteps along the towpath.
Canton Palace Theatre	Canton, Stark County	Ornate movie palace; spectral ‘White Lady’ and projection booth activity.
Lake County History Center	Painesville, Lake County	Former poorhouse; disembodied voices, doors, and footsteps.
Fairport Harbor Marine Museum & Lighthouse	Fairport Harbor, Lake County	Lightkeeper's quarters with a curious spirit and nautical residuals.
Marblehead Lighthouse	Marblehead, Ottawa County	Keeper lore of watchful figures and lantern light on calm nights.
Toledo Yacht Club	Toledo, Lucas County	Fires and storms mark its past; members note music and footsteps.
Collingwood Arts Center	Toledo, Lucas County	Former convent; shadow forms, voices, and artists' late-night encounters.
Oliver House	Toledo, Lucas County	19th-century hotel/complex; a gentleman apparition and clinking glasses.
Toledo Harbor Lighthouse	Offshore, Lucas County	Remote light with keepers' stories of movement in sealed rooms.
Hotel Breakers – Cedar Point	Sandusky, Erie County	Historic resort; housekeeping reports knocks and corridor figures.
Cedar Point & Lighthouse Point	Sandusky, Erie County	Park lore includes restless performers and lakeside shadows.
Norfolk & Western Railroad Bridge	Sandusky, Erie County	Late-night train whistles and phantom footsteps along the span.
Gill House	Galion, Crawford County	Wright-brothers-era home; voices, touches, and intelligent responses on investigations.
Bissman Building	Mansfield, Richland County	Former grocery warehouse; shadow masses and disembodied male voices.
Ohio State Reformatory (OSR)	Mansfield, Richland County	Iconic prison; full-body apparitions, the ‘Hole,’ and famed EVP captures.
Malabar Farm – Big House	Lucas, Richland County	Louis Bromfield's estate; door latches, footsteps, and romantic-era echoes.

Prospect Place (George Adams House)	Trinway, Muskingum County	Underground Railroad mansion; apparitions on the stair and servant■quarters knocks.
Twin City Opera House	McConnelsville, Morgan County	Stage whispers, shadow figures, and a well■known basement presence.
Ohio Statehouse	Columbus, Franklin County	Founders’ footsteps, Civil War echoes, and a blue■suited figure after hours.
Camp Chase Confederate Cemetery	Columbus, Franklin County	‘Lady in Gray’ searching the rows for a fallen soldier.
Kelton House Museum & Garden	Columbus, Franklin County	Underground Railroad site; parlor footsteps and gentle voices.
Thurber House	Columbus, Franklin County	Humorous hauntings tied to author James Thurber’s famous ghost stories.
Ohio Theatre	Columbus, Franklin County	Resident spirit ‘Fred’; phantom organ notes and balcony cold spots.
Southern Theatre	Columbus, Franklin County	Opera■house acoustics with lingering performers and backstage whispers.
Walhalla Ravine	Columbus, Franklin County	A winding ravine linked to a tragic 1920s tale and car■light apparitions.
Green Lawn Cemetery	Columbus, Franklin County	Victorian burial ground; orbs, figures, and chapel sounds.
The Jury Room	Columbus, Franklin County	Historic tavern; mirror tricks, footsteps, and a flirtatious bar spirit.
Cincinnati Music Hall	Cincinnati, Hamilton County	Built atop potter’s fields; musicians and patrons meet lingering residents.
Cincinnati Art Museum	Cincinnati, Hamilton County	Guard sightings of a roaming, well■dressed figure after closing.
Cincinnati Museum Center at Union Terminal	Cincinnati, Hamilton County	Echoes under the rotunda; staff hear voices near closed exhibits.
Spring Grove Cemetery & Arboretum	Cincinnati, Hamilton County	Monument■lined lanes; lights, figures, and quiet whispers.
Sedamsville Rectory	Cincinnati, Hamilton County	Notorious rectory; aggressive knocks, growls, and personal experiences.
Taft Museum of Art	Cincinnati, Hamilton County	Federal■style home; docents note perfume, footsteps, and a gentle presence.
The Dent Schoolhouse	Cincinnati, Hamilton County	Historic school turned haunt; janitor legend and real■deal activity claims.
Kings Island Amusement Park	Mason, Warren County	‘Tower Johnny’ and a small girl by the International Street fountain.
Golden Lamb Inn	Lebanon, Warren County	Ohio’s oldest inn; Sarah Stubbs’ room and Shaker■era figures.
National Exemplar (Mariemont Inn)	Mariemont, Hamilton County	Inn with piano notes and a friendly hallway apparition.
University of Dayton – The Watchtower (Patterson Tower)	Kettering, Dayton, Montgomery County	‘Witch’s Tower’ lore; lightning, tragedy, and night footsteps.
Woodland Cemetery & Arboretum	Dayton, Montgomery County	Wright brothers’ resting place; lantern lights among the stones.
Victoria Theatre	Dayton, Montgomery County	Backstage cold spots, rustling costumes, and balcony watchers.
Amber Rose Restaurant	Dayton, Montgomery County	Former deli & ballroom; dish clatter and figures in the stairwell.
Old Montgomery County Jail	Dayton, Montgomery County	Cell door slams, shouts, and shadowy forms along the block.
The Ridges (Athens Lunatic Asylum)	Athens, Athens County	Famed Kirkbride hospital; wards, cemeteries, and the ‘stain’ lore.
Ohio University – Wilson Hall & West Green	Athens, Athens County	Occult rumors; mirrors, dreams, and anomalous dorm activity.
Moonville Tunnel	Zaleski State Forest, Vinton County	Phantom lantern■man along the old rail bed and glowing lights.
Lake Hope State Park & Iron Furnace	Vinton County	Miner and furnace worker apparitions near the ruins.
Ash Cave & Old Man’s Cave	Hocking Hills, Hocking County	Whistles on empty trails and figures near waterfalls.

Rock House	Hocking Hills, Hocking County	Cavern ‘windows’ with peering silhouettes and 19th-century graffiti.
Ravenswood Castle grounds	New Plymouth, Vinton County	Medieval-style inn; castle-walk footsteps and peeking figures.
The Anchorage (Putnam House)	Marietta, Washington County	‘The House of Mystery’; a woman in blue and mirrored movement.
Lafayette Hotel	Marietta, Washington County	Riverfront inn; elevator antics and a dapper gentleman on 3rd floor.
Mound Cemetery	Marietta, Washington County	Ancient earthworks; guardian presences and blue lights.
Peoples Bank Theatre (Colony Theatre)	Marietta, Washington County	Projection booth knocks and velvet curtained shadows.
Ariel Opera House	Gallipolis, Gallia County	Disembodied singing and a spectral performer on stage left.
The Emmitt House (site)	Waverly, Pike County	Burned 2014; lingering street-side figures still reported.
Licking County Historic Jail	Newark, Licking County	Moans, footsteps, and intelligent knocks in cell blocks.
Zoar Village	Zoar, Tuscarawas County	Communal German settlement; hymns and lanterns on foggy nights.
Warther Museum grounds	Dover, Tuscarawas County	Tool room whispers and a craftsman’s presence at displays.
Gnadenhutten Massacre Site & Museum	Gnadenhutten, Tuscarawas County	Somber ground; prayer-like murmurs and chill spots.
Old Licking County Courthouse Square	Newark, Licking County	Shadows crossing windows and clock-tower knocks.
The Buxton Inn	Granville, Licking County	Blue Lady in the hallways; fireplace scents and clinking china.
Bryn Du Mansion	Granville, Licking County	Footsteps in the galleries and a figure in the tower.
Ye Olde Trail Tavern	Yellow Springs, Greene County	Frontier-era tavern; a prankish spirit bumps chairs and mugs.
Antioch College – Glen Helen & Springs	Yellow Springs, Greene County	Light anomalies, murmurs near the cascades, and woodland watchers.
Waverly Hills School (site lore)	Greene County region	Local tales of a teacher’s return at dusk; fleeting figure by steps.
Piqua – Fort Piqua Plaza (Library)	Piqua, Miami County	Former hotel; elevator calls, cigar smell, and lobby footsteps.
Old West End Homes	Toledo, Lucas County	Victorian houses with resident spirits and period aromas.
Ohio Northern University – Hill Building	Ada, Hardin County	Late-night footsteps and books sliding in quiet stacks.
Urbana – Piatt Castles (MacAuley/Cheek/MacGuffee)	Logansport, Adams/Campaign Counties	Castle museums; music boxes and window silhouettes.
Berea – Baldwin Wallace University, Martingale Hall	Berea, Cuyahoga County	Stage lights flicker and a costumed figure vanishes in wings.
Rogue’s Hollow	Doylestown, Wayne County	Old mining hollow; black dogs, headless riders, and a spectral miller.
Crybaby Bridge (Groveport)	Groveport, Franklin County	Late-night cries and car-stalls on the span.
Crybaby Bridge (Schneider St.)	Canton, Stark County	Local legends of drops in temperature and baby wails.
Cleveland – Tinker's Creek & Viaduct Park	Bedford, Cuyahoga County	Rail-era ghosts and water-spray voices near the gorge.
Helltown (Boston Mills)	Summit County	Abandoned homes lore; cemetery lights and mutant myths persist.
Oxford Light (Motorcycle Ghost)	Oxford, Butler County	A phantom headlight races a lonely country road at night.
Ghost Trolley of Brady Lake (lore)	Portage County	Railcar lights and bells heard long after the line closed.
Lima State Hospital (site / lore)	Lima, Allen County	Residual cries near foundations; hospital mostly gone, legends remain.

The Gill Memorial Hospital (site lore)	Steubenville area, Jefferson County	Quiet ground with reports of a woman in white.
Old Knox County Poorhouse (site)	Mt. Vernon, Knox County	Bricks and fields where figures cross at twilight.
Muskingum County Courthouse	Zanesville, Muskingum County	Doorknobs turn and footsteps linger after closing.
Belmont County Sheriff’s Residence & Jail	St. Clairsville, Belmont County	Cell whispers and a sheriff’s boots on the stairs.
Athens County Cemeteries (Numbers 1–3)	Athens, Athens County	Students report orbs, mists, and guardian presences.
Riverside Cemetery	Cleveland, Cuyahoga County	Victorian grounds; cloak■like figures between mausoleums.
Union Cemetery	Steubenville, Jefferson County	Lantern■like lights and a robed figure on the ridge.
Lake View Park – Rose Garden	Lorain, Lorain County	After■dark perfume and a 1920s couple seen arm■in■arm.
Lorain Lighthouse	Lorain, Lorain County	Keepers’ footsteps and windows opening on calm waters.
Hotel Lafayette (The Lafayette)	Marietta, Washington County	Riverboat■era guests stroll the halls; elevator has a mind of its own.
The Spread Eagle Tavern	Hanoverton, Columbiana County	Early■American inn; boots on the landing and rattling pans.
The Sebring Mansion Inn & Spa	Sebring, Mahoning County	A lady in a high■neck dress; mirrors shift in candlelight.
The Big House at Prospect Place	Trinway, Muskingum County	Servant calls and a conductor’s footsteps by the rear stairs.
Stambaugh Auditorium	Youngstown, Mahoning County	Pipe■organ sighs and a tuxedoed figure on balcony rail.
Warner Theatre (Packard Music Hall area lore)	Warren, Trumbull County	Music■hall shadows and lobby cold pockets.
Ritz Theatre	Tiffin, Seneca County	Stage lights flare and seats fold after final bows.
Majestic Theatre	Chillicothe, Ross County	‘The Bloody Theatre’; 1918 flu lore and stage whispers.
Stuart’s Opera House	Nelsonville, Athens County	Smoke■like forms and children’s laughter backstage.
St. Joseph Cemetery	Lockbourne, Franklin County	Statue turns and a mourning mother visits after midnight.
St. Peter-in-Chains Cathedral (lore)	Cincinnati, Hamilton County	Organ chords and a robed figure crossing the nave.
Woodland Cemetery (Cleveland Heights)	Cuyahoga County	Lanterns among trees and a groundskeeper’s silhouette.
Muth Cemetery (Witch’s Grave lore)	Knox County region	Folk■magic stories and a watchful figure near the fence.
