

Privacy Policy

Eagle's Landing RV Park, Inc. respects the importance of the privacy of your Personal Information. This Privacy Policy discloses privacy practices for information we collect at our campground and on our website www.eagleslandingrvpark.com.

By using our web site, reserving a site, or staying at our campground, you consent to our policy.

When you book a reservation to stay at our campground, either by using the On Line Booking Feature on our web site, or by calling us, we collect the following personal information: your name, address, phone number, email address, credit card information, type and size of your RV, number of people staying in your RV (and their name), number and type of pets in your RV.

We use your information to facilitate booking reservations at our campground, confirming reservations, and to quickly process transactions when you arrive.

We implement a variety of security measures to maintain the safety of your personal information. Your personal information is contained within secured networks and databases and is only accessible by a limited number of persons who have the authority to access it for the purposes stated above and to maintain our database. All such persons are required to keep your information confidential.

When you use the On Line Booking Feature on our web site, all sensitive and credit card information you provide is transmitted and encrypted into our database using only networks which are PCI compliant and secured via nationally and industry accepted standards, to be only accessed as stated above.

We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer to outside parties your personally identifiable information, with the exception of, web site hosting partners and other parties who assist us in operating our web site, conducting our business, or servicing you, so long as those parties agree to keep the information confidential. We may also release your personal or contact information when we believe release is appropriate to comply with the law, cooperate with law enforcement, enforce our site policies, or protect ours' or others' rights, property, or safety.

If we decide to change our Privacy Policy, we will post those changes on our web site, and in our office.
