St. Michael the Archangel Pregnancy Help Center is blessed to be working with Kathleen Dorman, MSN, RN, from the Nurse-Family Partnership at the Visiting Nurse Association Health Group in support of first-time families. As part of this effort, St. Michael's is providing baby items and supplies to mothers participating in the program.

The Nurse-Family Partnership connects eligible first-time pregnant women to a registered nurse. Through regular visits, nurses provide guidance, education, and support throughout pregnancy and early childhood to promote healthy outcomes for both mother and baby. The program is free for those who qualify (28 weeks pregnant or less, meet income requirements, and live in Ocean or Monmouth County).
