PRAYERS NEEDED FOR DEBRA, BABY AND MEDICAL PROFESSIONALS

Please pray for our mom, Debra, who came to our center, seven months pregnant. The doctors told her that her baby has Down Syndrome. Up until four months, the doctors were pressuring her to abort this baby. She said “no.” She had to leave her OBGYN because the pressure to abort this baby had grown so great.

When she came to St. Michael’s, we were set to give Debra all the baby items she needed. But she was crying and said that what she needed most was prayer. So, we stopped everything and prayed with her. After that, she began feeling better and she was able to pick out items for her baby.

She was so thankful and said: “This is a big relief for me.” “This is a miracle... I was wondering how I was going to pay for all of these things ... You guys are a blessing.”

We assured her that we would continue to support her, and that we would continue to be there for her and asked her to stay in touch. We let her know that God was so pleased with her decision to stand for the life of her child—most especially amid such strong opposition from medical professionals.

By the time she left St. Michael’s, Debra was glowing.

Please pray for Debra that she will always have such courageous faith, for the health of her pre-born baby and for all the doctors and OBGYNs who would seek to take the blessing of life from the womb—which ought to be the safest place in the world.
