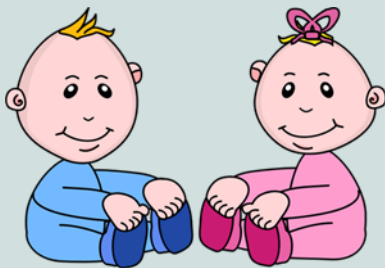
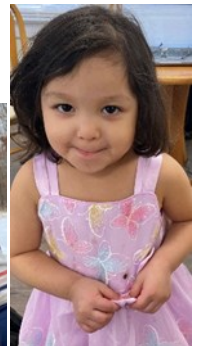
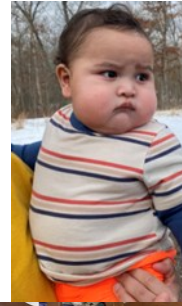
BRINGING HELP TO THE HOSPITAL:

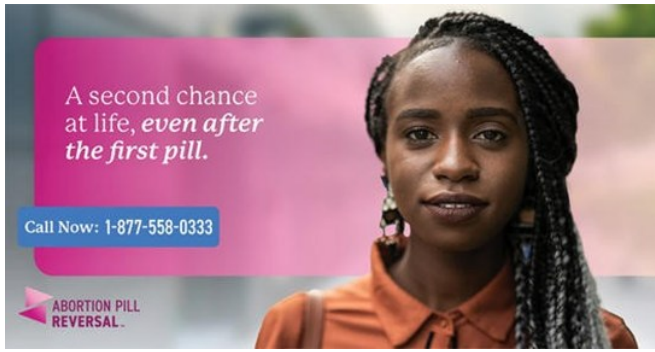

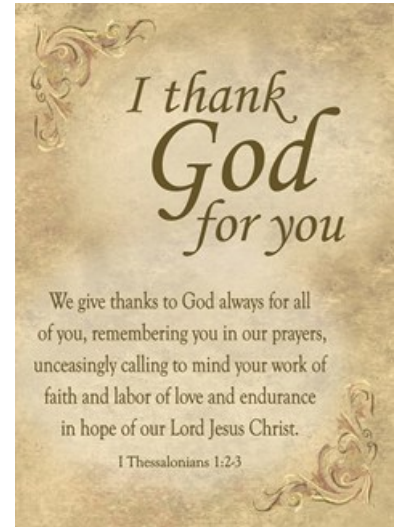
HOW IS ST. MICHAEL'S ASSISTING MOMS AND BABIES AND FAMILIES?

Here are just a few examples: One mom, with her baby less than one year old was without a place to live and unable to navigate her situation through social services. We were able to refer her to the PATH Ministry, where assistance was provided to help get her into a safe place to live.

Another young mom, with the baby still in the womb could not afford needed baby essentials. Her husband was finishing his education. We were able to supply her with needed baby supplies so she and her husband could provide for the baby yet he could continue with his education.

Abortion Pill Use is Growing, but Abortion Pill Reversal (APR) is Saving Lives!

More than half of abortions in the U.S. occur through the "abortion pill." As these numbers continue to rise, we believe that **no woman should ever feel forced to finish an abortion she regrets after having started the abortion pill process.** The Abortion Pill Rescue Network connects women who have taken the first dose of the Abortion Pill to a network of medical professionals trained to administer the Abortion Pill Reversal protocol.

From the moment a woman takes the abortion pill, she has about 72 hours to change her mind and try to save her baby. The [Abortion Pill Rescue Network](#), through Option Line's 24/7 contact center, answers an average of 200 mission-critical calls a month from women who regret their abortion decision. Statistics show that thousands of lives have been saved (and counting) through the abortion pill reversal protocol! Seeking a last chance to choose life for their little ones, women can reach out to the Abortion Pill Rescue Network and be connected with a local medical provider who starts the Abortion Pill Reversal Process.
