Marble Care & Maintenance

Daily Cleaning:

- Clean marble with a damp cloth and pH-neutral cleaner designed for natural stone.
- Do not use acidic or abrasive cleaners (e.g., vinegar, lemon, bleach).

Sealing:

- Marble should be sealed every 6-12 months depending on use.
- Use a marble-specific penetrating sealer and test for water absorption to determine need.

Stain and Etch Prevention:

- Wipe spills immediately—especially acidic substances like wine, tomato sauce, and citrus juice.
- Marble is susceptible to etching (dull spots from acid) and staining.
- Use coasters, trays, and placemats wherever possible.

Scratch and Chip Prevention:

- Marble is a soft stone—avoid dragging heavy or sharp items across the surface.
- Use cutting boards and avoid direct knife contact.

Polishing and Repairs:

- Marble can be professionally polished to restore luster if dulled.
- Etches and deep scratches may require refinishing by a stone professional.
