GOING WITHOUT THE HOLY EUCHARIST

March 23, 2020, was the last time I received our Lord in the Eucharist. Today is the sixth week that I have gone without His body and blood.

Had you asked me last year what going without the Eucharist for six weeks would be like, I probably would have said impossible. Strangely, viewing daily Livestream Mass is feeding me spiritual food for the journey we are on. Somehow, while I miss receiving Him in Holy communion, I am not longing for Him because I know He is always with me.

I know when we break the bread, He is sharing Himself with us. He does not give us a loaf of bread, but He shares His body with us to strengthen us. Maybe going to daily Mass for 11 years has built up a reserve that gives me the strength

to carry on.

What I do miss the most about not being able to enter my parish is the fellowship with mostly the morning Mass gang. Jesus taught the apostles that worshiping together would bring them closer to Him. I can feel closer to Jesus in the company of the morning Mass attendees more than if I'm just at home or in the car. There is strength in numbers, I guess.

According to our governor, we have till May 28 until we can gather again for Holy Communion.

2020 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Jan 13, 2020: Vision 2020 Meeting with Board of Directors to continue from 2019 our commitment to refine and improve how we reach young families. We invited Keri Ann Tarrant to address our meeting and committed to a 33 Days to Morning Glory program for the directors. We discussed many options that need more time to develop.

Jan 17, 2020: Chesterton Academy of Detroit Letter of Understanding for the high school teens to be invited to join the Chesterton Men of the Sacred Heart Honor Society. Peter Ohotnicky (Headmaster) is excited to run this pilot program at the newest Chesterton Academy (30 currently open in USA).

Feb 3, 2020: Our 2019 Yearbook was mailed to 2000 homes and organizations. We increased the publication from 1500 to 2000 to meet demand based on last years mailing. The book contained a center pull out section for the John LoVasco Memorial.

Feb 12, 2020: Reached agreement with the Sacred Heart Enthronement Network (SHEN) to support with a \$250 monthly donation that is being matched



by the Columbus Oh Sacred Heart group. Columbus and Detroit set up the SHEN to promote home enthronement to areas not covered by Detroit and Columbus.

March 6, 2020: Reached out to
the Newman Connection offering free
college dorm or home room Enthronement of the
Sacred Heart of Jesus packages containing the color
image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, program to
follow with self or friends, and introduction letter.
Then Covid 19 hit.

April-May, worked on a Parish based Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus program where families sign up to come to a celebration of the Enthronement at church, Father blesses the images of the Sacred Heart and the Immaculate Heart, salt to bless their homes, the Consecration prayers are recited by each family who then get their photo taken by the Men of the Sacred Hearts who will mail them the 8X10" photo to the family who was given the matching frame at the church ceremony.

We launched this program at Holy Family in Memphis and St. Augustine in Richmond, Michigan on November 22, the Feast of Christ the King. We had 43 families sign up from both parishes. We then offered the 3ft statue of Our Lady of Fatima to be delivered for two weeks, and 9 families signed up for this added feature.

June, after a lengthy discussion, the Board made the decision to not renew the 6200 Chicago Road office lease, move the Executive Director to a home-based office with supplies being housed at U-Haul in Rochester. The Office Manager will do the books and send out notices for prayers as before from her home. This move will save more than \$15,000 per year. The move was complete by the end of July, but it took till the end of September to iron out the bumps.

August-December, while home enthronements to the Sacred Heart slowed to a death march due to teams not wanting to venture out, the Executive Director began collecting statues of Our Lady of Fatima from the teams and offered to drop Her off at homes requesting the statue to visit for two weeks. As of November 1, 2020; there were 23 statues that were being circulated to homes in the metro Detroit area. Our friends who had medical, physical or hardships requested the statue for comfort and to focus their petitions to Jesus. The statues are delivered and picked up by the Executive Director who also provides some of the families with the Home Enthronement Ceremonial Book if requested.

When picking up the statue, most of the people have filled out prayer petition for us to pray for them. What used to take months to fill, our prayer box now needs to be emptied monthly. On Frist Friday, the Executive Director takes the box to St. Andrews where Fr. Craig Marion blesses the prayers in the box and leaves it on the Altar, then during Adoration, each prayer is taken out and prayed for. Then the prayers are put into a coffee can and burned.





CAN YOU IMAGINE THIS?

At the last Supper, Jesus lays out the events that will happen in the next few days to his closest friends. Try to put yourself in Jesus' sandals as well as the disciples' sandals. Jesus is giving the most important information during a Passover supper, with wine no less.

First, He details how the simple bread and wine will become his body and blood for our salvation. Pity the poor disciples who have traveled with Jesus for three years and witnessed His miracles and His wisdom. I can assume they wanted to believe He could change the bread and wine into His Body and Blood, but what was that part again about salvation? No wonder they had to go into hiding for 40 days until Pentecost!

Then Jesus, the Son of God, submits Himself to the humility of being arrested by the Jews, scourged at a pillar, tortured and spat upon, marched through the city carrying His cross, and finally nailed to a cross and left to die. I think of how He could have turned the Jew's who arrested Him into mice or stopped the beating and the crucifixion at any time. What was the driving force that propelled Him to submit to that treatment?

The plan was that Jesus would take the suffering required to gain forgiveness for your sins and mine. Someone had to pay, and Jesus stood up and took the pain and suffered for the sins you and I commit daily. The only way we get to heaven is through Jesus. No Jesus, no Heaven.

Chesterton Academy of Detroit and Men of the Sacred Hearts have partnered to create a magnificent program for the young men who will attend Chesterton Academy of Detroit. Chesterton Men of the Sacred Hearts Honor Society will be an opportunity for male students to grow in virtue, prepare for Catholic manhood, lead spiritually in the school, and participate in the home enthronement ministry of Men of the Sacred Hearts.

For more than 50 years, the Men of the Sacred Hearts in southeast Michigan have been promoting evangelization through the consecration of homes, businesses, and parishes to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. With 24 teams and 122 members across the state, the Men of the Sacred Hearts now book enthronements for homes, businesses, and schools up to a year in advance.

Developing a program for Chesterton Academy of Detroit with Men of the Sacred Hearts grew out of a home enthronement of the school's founders, David,



and Alejandra Miller. After sharing the story of founding the classical high school, the idea for a club and character development program came to life. "The most beautiful part of all of this is we were simply having our home enthroned, and we — the men and ourselves — felt this was a grace from Our Lady to bring us together," Alejandra Miller said.

The program will have several components. First, male leaders in the school, fathers, Men of the Sacred Hearts, priests, and other male role models will lead a weekly lesson with boys about growing in Catholic manhood. Examples would be: leading the family spiritually, discerning one's vocation, responsibility, and chivalry. Young men who demonstrate the desire to be a spiritual leader by implementing the lessons, living their Catholic faith, serving at Holy Mass with reverence, or dedicating themselves to sacred music, will be invited into the Chesterton Men of the Sacred Hearts Honor Society (CMSHHS). Gentlemen who accept will be inducted in a special ceremony and given a Sacred Heart pin for their jacket lapel. "We intend to make this a high honor and coveted distinction for the young men in our school," said Headmaster Peter Ohotnicky. "There is no fixed quota of how many or what percent of the male students can be in the Chesterton Men of the Sacred Hearts Honor Society, but we want all our young men to inspire to be part of this group." Those in the Honor Society will then have the opportunity to learn and then participate in the home enthronement ministry, starting with their own schoolmates' homes.

"We would like to see every family who becomes part of the Chesterton Academy community have their home enthroned to the Sacred Hearts," said David Tay, Executive Director of Men of the Sacred Hearts. "We anticipate that Chesterton Men of the Sacred Hearts Honor Society will be a great means of evangelization for Catholic families, schools, and businesses in our area. We are eager to involve these young men in our work. It will also set a foundation for these students to grow into Catholic men who will be leaders of the faith for the rest of their lives."














CHOICES


with knees at your chin. The full flight showed people quite uncomfortable and cranky toddlers, and kids were doing most of the complaining.


On a sunny, cool June 13, 2020, Deacon Colin became Father Colin at the Most Blessed Sacrament

Fr. Joe's Jottings

Today is the **Feast of Divine Mercy**—an official Church devotion based on the revelations given by Jesus in the 1930s to a Polish nun, St. Faustina Kowalska. The numerous messages and visions she received highlight the Lord's immense willingness to forgive sinners—and the terrible consequences of rejecting Divine Mercy, and thus subjecting oneself to Divine Justice.

The many mystical experiences Sr. Faustina had included visits to Heaven, Hell, and Purgatory. As she describes in her Diary: Divine Mercy in My Soul, "Today I was led by an Angel to the chasms of Hell. It is a place of great torture; how awesomely large and extensive it is! The kinds of torture I saw: the first torture that constitutes Hell is loss of God; the second is perpetual remorse of conscience; the third is that one's condition will never change; the fourth is the fire that will penetrate the soul without destroying it-a terrible suffering, since it is a purely spiritual fire, lit by God's anger; the fifth torture is continual darkness and a terrible suffocating smell, and, despite the darkness, the devils and the souls of the damned see each other and all the evil, both others and their own; the sixth torture is the constant company of Satan; the seventh torture is horrible despair, hatred of God, vile words, curses and blasphemies. . . . Each soul undergoes terrible and indescribable sufferings, related to the manner in which it has sinned" (Diary, #741).

In regard to Purgatory, the saint writes, "I saw my Guardian Angel, who ordered me to follow him. In a moment I was in a misty place of fire in which there was a great crowd of suffering souls. They were praying fervently, but to no avail, for themselves; only we can come to their aid [by our prayers and sacrifices, offered on their behalf]. . . . My Guardian Angel did not leave me for an instant. I asked these souls what their greatest suffering was. They answered me in one voice that their greatest torment was longing for God. I saw Our Lady visiting the souls in Purgatory. The souls call her 'The Star of the Sea.' She brings them refreshment. . . . We went out of that place of suffering. [I heard the Lord say] 'My Mercy does not want this, but Justice demands it.' Since that time, I am in closer communion with the suffering souls" (Diary, #20).

St. Faustina also writes, "Today I was in Heaven, in spirit, and I saw its inconceivable beauties and the happiness that awaits us after death. I saw how all creatures give ceaseless praise and glory to God. I saw how great is happiness in God, which spreads to all creatures, making them happy; and then all the glory and praise which springs from this happiness returns to its source, and they enter into the depths of God" (Diary, #779).

"Souls are penetrated by His divinity and pass from brightness to brightness, an unchanging light, but never monotonous, always new though never changing. O Holy Trinity, make Yourself known to souls!" (*Diary*, #592).

Describing a vision related to our eternal destiny, St. Faustina writes, "One day, I saw two roads. One was broad, covered with sand and flowers, full of joy, music and all sorts of pleasures. People walked along it, dancing and enjoying themselves. They reached the end without realizing it. And at the end of the road there was a horrible precipice; that is, the abyss of Hell. The souls fell blindly into it; as they walked, so they fell. And their number was so great that it was impossible to count them. And I saw the other road, or rather, a path, for it was narrow and strewn with thorns and rocks; and the people who walked along it had tears in their eyes, and all kinds of suffering befell them. Some fell down upon the rocks, but stood up immediately and went on. At the end of the road there was a magnificent garden filled with all sorts of happiness, and all these souls entered there. At the very first instant they forgot all their sufferings" (Diary, #153).

This vision, of course, is reminiscent of Jesus' words, "Enter through the narrow gate, for the gate is wide and the road broad that leads to destruction" (Mt. 7:13). As Our Lord told the saint, "I do not want to punish an aching mankind, but desire to heal it, pressing it to My Merciful Heart" (Diary, #1588). It is entirely possible—if not likely—that our world is now undergoing a chastisement or cleansing, in which the Lord is inviting humanity to repent of its many sins and seek His Mercy. Also, we as individuals are reminded not only that our moral decisions have eternal consequences, but that our current sufferings are known to God, and can be a preparation for eternal joy and glory.

When God is ignored by His children, He uses every possible means—including suffering—to get their attention, begging them to repent and urging them to choose life (cf. Dt. 30:15-20). Today's Feast of Divine Mercy is a promise that those whose lives are rooted in the love of God have nothing to fear, and everything to gain.

A pastor was depressed because he had just been beaten rather badly in a round of golf by one of his parishioners, a man some thirty years older than him. Trying to console him, the parishioner said, "Cheer up, Father; you'll win in the end. You'll be burying me some day." "Even then," the priest responded, "it will be your hole."

Thought for the Day:

Jesus shows His hands and His side [to the Apostles, as described in today's Gospel—John 20:19-31]. He points, that is, to the wounds of the Passion, especially the wound in His Heart, the source from which flows the great wave of mercy poured out on humanity.

As a result, being alone with myself (and God) took a



HOLY FAMILY & ST. AUGUSTINE SUCCESS!

Before the Covid-19 lockdown happened in March 2020, the Men of the Sacred Hearts were visiting homes by appointment and helping families Enthrone the Sacred Heart of Jesus in the family and home.

We had 29 teams and 118 volunteers that were active in making appointments and helping our neighbors increase their prayer life. Today, November 13, 2020, as I write this article, we have 15 teams with 55 volunteers working in some capacity. Home Enthronement revenue from donations dropped 63% through November.

In May-October, we were able to resume some regular schedules and began visiting homes in person, by conference call, or by Zoom. Donations that had dried up began to flow again, until October when the Covid ramped up.

My team experienced two of our youngest members stricken with Covid-19 and in quarantine. With that news, most of the remaining team wisely opted out of home visits for the time being. We suspended the

program until further notice on November 12, 2020.

I notified the homes we had appointments for face-toface visits that we were resuming the earlier practice of bringing our Lady's statue to the porch to have the family wipe down it and then bring it into the home. All excepted this practice.

Back to Holy Family in Memphis and St. Augustine in Richmond, Michigan. I advised my board that we had a crisis situation and needed another way to get families to continue inviting Jesus into their home. At this point, I should add that for the past 7 years; we have been experimenting with how to cope with a lack of young volunteers and a volunteer force that was aging and retiring.

Jim Nihem from our board came up with an idea of including Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and Enthronement of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Jim and I hammered out a program based on the Pastor leading Adoration and Enthronement, including a Holy Mass. We each had one Pastor that we thought would be interested, and my choice of Fr. Phil Ching of Holy Family and St. Augustine was "all in."

However, Father made some changes to the program to fit his community. Due to timing, we had to drop Adoration and have the ceremony after the 9 AM Holy Mass at St. Augustine and the 10:30 AM Holy Mass at Holy Family. A few more back and forths to polish the 16-page ceremony book, and we were ready to present it to his flock.

I did the 2-minute pitch after each of the 6 Masses on Nov 6 and 7. The photo above is my sign-up table at St. Augustine.

We were offering the families who signed up a family named personalized ceremony book to keep. Salt for Father to bless the home's doors and rooms. An image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and Immaculate Heart of Mary to Enthrone and a professional photo taken by our own Joe Bauer of JB Studios of the family with Father during the blessing of the image, salt, and ceremony book.

We had 41 families signed up.

\$40 a month flip phone morphed into the \$75 a month plan, but I was happy with my new toy.

Did you know you could play Euchre with other people or the computer on the smartphone? Even chess. Before I knew it, I was watching News and Sports on the damn thing.

I found myself reaching for the smartphone when I was not doing something with my two hands. I had become everyone else, addicted to the phone, and the necessity to answer texts immediately. To review the Newsfeed for the latest atrocity, President Trump did an hour ago. What was the new weather alert? Anyone put a recent Twitter message up that could interest me. I thought I was holier than thou by not succumbing to Facebook (in reality, I honestly did not understand why I wanted to see Suzie's birthday pictures).

When Lent was days away, I made the deal. No more smartphone unless it was to find a home or confirm an appointment. I put the damn thing down.

Ash Wednesday was the hardest as I kept pulling it out of my pocket and putting it back again.

Thursday was just as bad, and now I was in full withdrawal. Friday was focused on not thinking about all the news I was missing or weather alerts. Saturday was more manageable as my team was scheduled for two homes. We went to Holy Mass that afternoon, built a big fire, and had a steak for dinner, and now it was getting easier.

Sunday, I could eat, do and celebrate as I wanted. But as I picked up the damn phone to check the news, I lost interest. I did not check Twitter or my text account. I pickup up the Holy Bible and read Scripture. At 11:30 AM, I looked up from Genesis and thought that I was honestly happier than I had been with that damn phone in my hand.

Like a drug addict or an alcoholic, I began to feel free from my addiction. Now I can see where I was wasting time on a thing that was taking me away from God.






I then took the statue to Rich and Tonya's home and again put the statue on their porch with books. It was a re-enthronement, so they did not need an image.

"The Heart of Jesus is an open heart. Spend your time there." - St. Mother Teresa

"Come be My light...they don't know Me so they don't want me. You come...carry Me to them." *The words of Jesus to Mother Teresa, 1946.*

There is no more urgent message for the world today than the earnest plea of the Heart of Jesus, a plea that mankind would respond to His love and return love for love. This message imbued in all of Sacred Scripture has been echoed down through the centuries to numerous saints, saints like St. Margaret Mary, St. Faustina, Fr. Mateo, and St. Teresa of Calcutta, along with so many others. My heartfelt gratitude to each of you, the Men of Sacred Hearts for the crucial role you play in fulfilling this burning desire of the Heart of Jesus. On March 25th of this year, the Solemnity of the Annunciation, we renewed together the Marian Consecration, asking the Blessed Mother to take this apostolate more deeply than ever before into the mystery of His Heart and to guide each of you toward the vision and mission that God wishes to accomplish through you. I cannot wait to see the great fruit and grace that will be evident in the upcoming weeks and months as you experience a new morning glory in this apostolate.

"My little one, come...come, carry Me into the holes of the poor. Come be My light. I cannot go alone, they don't know Me so they don't want me. You come, go among them. Carry me with you into them. How I long to enter theirdark unhappy homes."

The above quote is taken from the hidden journals of St. Teresa of Calcutta which were released after her death in 2002 at the time of her beatification. Why have we not heard of this message before? Mother

herself kept this guarded and hidden. She had written of this powerful vision and of the words of Jesus to her in her secret diary, but spoke of it to no one, not even to the closest of her Sisters. She lived this out in an evidential way with great force and faithfulness. These words led her to found the Missionaries of Charity to fulfill His cry of thirst and the deep desires of the Heart of Christ. Her reason for silence in this matter was also revealed in her journal. It appears that in her humility she was fearful that if others knew of these extraordinary visions that Jesus had given to her, that they would, "...think more of her and less of Jesus." It was in fact her profound humility, which she drew from the Heart of Jesus, that caused her to keep silence in the midst of so incredible a gift.



Mother Teresa knew well that *Mary always leads us to Jesus*, and to a more profound union with Him. She was often heard to say that the role of Mary is "to bring us face to face with the love in the Heart of Christ Crucified." Mother herself was set aflame with a desire to love Jesus and to make him loved from her earliest years. She had been taught by Jesuit Missionaries. The Heart of Christ and his Thirst for Souls was ever in the forefront of her mind and heart.

In Memory of John LoVasco

"A Life That Touches Others Goes On Forever"

The account of this hidden call of Christ can be found in a book compiled by the Missionaries of Charity, entitled "Come, be My Light," by Fr. Brian Kolodiejchuk.

Most significant for us is to remember that this call from Jesus to Mother to *Come be His light* and *to carry Him to the world* was not simply a call for Mother alone or even for her beloved Sisters, the Missionaries of Charity. This call, she herself knew was an essential one for the whole Church and for every believer. May this long Lent of 2020 be the decisive turning point in which we feel like never before the fire of this call to go out and bring Christ into the homes and hearts of all those we encounter. Like Mary and with Mary may we go in haste to fulfill this urgent plea of Jesus from the Cross, to make Him known and loved, reigniting the flame of His love on this earth by strengthening the weary, healing the broken, and making the world whole again with His love.

Chesterton Our Lady of Guadalupe Academy is a high school occupying the St. Luke's Lutheran High School (closed down last year) on Metropolitan Parkway in Clinton Township. The current 30 existing Chesterton High Schools are limited to 140 students over the 9th thru 12th grade.

The Chesterton Our Lady of Guadalupe school had a target of 20 students to open for the 2020-21 Academic year. The school enrolled 23 and capped the enrollment so they would not have to hire another teacher this year.

Frist period every day is Holy Mass at St. Francesco that is just one mile east of the school. Attendance is taken during this first period. The students are then carpooled to school.

The Chesterton model teaches in the classical Catholic tradition using Humanities, Fine Arts, Math, and Science, focusing on Faith. All subjects are taught in the Socratic method (argumentative dialogue between individuals based on asking and answering questions to stimulate critical thinking).

On Tuesday, after lunch, the 23 students played 15 minutes of volleyball. 9th, 10th, and 11th graders (no 12th grade this year) combined boys and girls on each team and proceeded to punish the volleyball. The students were joined by Canon Michael Stein, the Rector of St. Joseph Shrine on Jay Street in Detroit, and the Chesterton school's Spiritual Director. Being young, he not only kept up but showed some excellent ball skills to the delight of his side of the net.

This Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus will be a yearly event hosted by the Chesterton Men of the Sacred Hearts Honor Society made up of young men chosen to be in the Society by their leadership and faith ability.
