The Haunts of novelist, artist and jazz musician, Ted Lewis, in his Hometown of Barton upon Humber

How a boy born to the Manchester WW2 blitz from grew up in a very different rural town and returned from The Smoke after finding fame and a fortune

Trail 1 – Hometown Influences - 6th July 2026

Finishing with a hearty breakfast at The White Lion, the tour includes Ted's homes and the views and places he haunted, influenced his writing and so much more

Gather at 0900 for a 0930 start, arriving at White Lion for breakfast (not included) at 1130

Trail 2 – In a Thin Glass – 12 July 2026

Order a thin glass as you snap your fingers at the bar of Charlies (Steam Packet) trace your steps past Ted's homes, his first school, where he started for Hull Art college and cinemas that inspired him and more.

Gather at 1000 for a 1030 start, arriving at The Steam Packet (now Charlies) at 1230

Trail 3 – A Route to Literary Inspiration – 2 August '26

Including Ted's homes, haunts, pubs, trace his favourite haunts to Baysgarth House where he studied under the literary giant, Henry Treece. Relax in Stables Café in lovely Baysgarth Park Grammar School.

With the promise of tasty food or an ice cream at Stables Café

Gather at 1230 for a 1300 start. Arriving at Stables at 1500
