The food selection is not as varied as the Saturday morning market, and is more typical of a flea or state fair. But it is hardy, and from the looks of it most people did not mind the variety and selection.





For food there is an entire food court that has the typical roach coach type food fare. I say this affectionately and most people will know what I'm talking about. Don't let the term fool you. The food is a good quality.



This market has a lot of used clothes. I suppose that's the aspect of it which is more typical of a flea market. This brings a lot of younger kids. There are many more younger adults at this market than the Saturday morning market.

This was a nice touch a museum of mom. I suppose that's a good idea. We have museums for just about everything else! And the furniture is quite unique.






