
Every media used in art is represented at this festival. And these are individual artists that come from across the United States and the world. You will find crafts and art available at every price range up to the thousands of dollars.



Plan on spending at least two or three hours if you want to at a minimum walk through each booth. The festival is spread out across Straub Park and Has just under 300 vendors.



So far every festival date seems to be that perfect blend of temperature, humidity and sunshine that Florida is famous for. Today was no exception. But remember to bring hat, sunglasses and put your lotion on because it can get hot in the sun.



There's a tremendous number and a variety of paintings and original painted art at this festival. If you are a collector, or if you have a great Florida room that needs some color, then this is the festival for you.

What's nice about the festival is that the artist is there for you to talk to. They can explain their works better than anyone else and you are not in a art gallery facing an aggressive sales agent that doesn't know anything about the art they sell; just the price!



Wander around, take one lap around the festival and then double back to get your favorite items. I always shop for Christmas, birthdays and special occasions at this festival. You can find reasonably priced handmade artistic gifts which will be well received







Don't forget there are culinary arts as well located near the entrance to the Saint Petersburg harbor. There you can consume a light lunch or buy a glass of wine.

Mainsail is produced by nonprofit volunteer organizations. It has been holding the festival in St. Petersburg FL for 50 years. I have been coming to this festival since my early 30s and have never walked away without being amazed . I stated many times that the common perception is that there is no artistic talent in the United states any longer . But one afternoon spent at this festival will dispel that rumor completely .



And the creative variety is really endless. Artists come with different media, cultures and ideas and blend them into an art form that is unique . One thing the organizers do effectively for this festival is not to invite duplicate artists that produce similar media . You wind up with a stunning variety of art which go from leather, to wood and from glass , to clothing. There is something here for everyone I am sure .







The festival also has a competitive aspect. Confirming that we do have art for sale is the fact that we have a judged competition for the different media and artists. I have to assume that these ribbons are highly coveted for the artists and that they will use these in their marketing for sure. It would be a heady thing to win a place in this competition, given the incredible talent that is on display.



Last year I purchased some designer clothing produced by a firm in Atlanta . This clothing is worn in Ghana, Africa and it's hard not to fall in love with the bright colors. When I gave this gift to my daughter she was very impressed and could not believe I had found something so unique. That is the benefit of this festival.

But wander around, look at all of the options you have and then make a selection.






