The event is outdoors and an annual production from American stage. Each year at about this time the American stage performers put on a play or other drama at Demens Landing. It's great to get outside and there are different seating areas. We chose the blanket area as it is closer to the stage. Tickets are generally available online and if you go to american stage.org you can find this and other productions .





Needless to say some people go all out. As this is general seating these creative people must have arrived very early for their spot. It started out as a beautiful day with some cloud cover. We quickly found a place close to the stage. As you can see food, drinks, even champagne is permitted. So if you want to have a picnic or a light snack it would be great to bring that along.

The American stage also has a full bar and other sundries available at the back of the seated area. The prices are a bit high but it prevents you from carrying everything with you.



It's good to arrive 45 minutes to an hour early. Bring some snacks, sandwiches and chips and just sit down and have a picnic. You can have a leisurely light dinner right before the play starts which is perfect.

There are plenty of porta potties available at the site. These are well maintained and cleaned and they include hand wash stations.



Unfortunately I do not have any images of the production as videotaping and photography was prohibited.

The only observation I had, which I passed along to American stage, is that there was no dialogue between the actors. They just sang all the songs from the play one after another. I felt that this was disjointed and you could not really follow the storyline that must have been part of hair's tremendous success. But we did enjoy the evening.
