

Whereas, L.I.F.T. (the Association) has determined that the goals of the Association and the goals of the Prairie Development Association (PDA) are consistent with each other and that the Association and its members will benefit from becoming an Associate Member of the PDA and the PDA has determined that it would benefit from entering into an association with the Association. Association Representatives have read and understand the Membership Agreement for the PDA, the Association therefore has voted to become an Associate Member of the Prairie Development Association and the Prairie Development Association has agreed to allow the Association to be an associate of the PDA and its members who apply and pay their dues to be Private Members of the PDA on this the 14 day of November, 2025 :

The Association and PDA will agree to the following terms and conditions:

- A. The Association will establish a Security and Vetting Team to ensure that potential Private Members are those of like mind and good intentions that will work in good faith;
- B. The Association will establish a Compassion Team to ensure that the public is cared for so that there is less angst against the Members in the community if the Members are thriving;
- C. The Association will establish a Communications Team to ensure that the area has secure communications between itself and the PDA;
- D. The Association and its members shall keep all information regarding the PDA confidential;
- E. The Association will establish a Supply Chain Team to work with Sojourners and the Prairie Freedom Fund;
 - a. The Supply Chain Team will determine in consultation with Sojourners Supply Chain the local distribution system that is best suited to the area;
 - b. The Supply Chain Team will be led by a Lead Coordinator who will interact with the PDA. The Lead Coordinator will be selected by the Association with the approval of the PDA;
 - c. The Supply Chain Team will also include all the local Coordinators from the region around the Association. The PDA suggests that there be one Coordinator per town who are selected by Sojourners in consultation with the Association's Supply Chain Team;
 - d. The Supply Chain Team will in consultation with the Association Board also appoint a Sojourners Advisory Board Member to the PDA who is not a Coordinator;

- e. The Supply Chain Team in consultation with the Association Board will appoint two (2) Prairie Freedom Fund Advisory Board members to the PDA to act as Advisors and members of Loan Committees;
- F. The Association will appoint a Commissioner to sit on the PDA Dispute Resolution Committee. This Commissioner ideally will be elected by the local Association members or appointed by the local Association Board and will be someone of sound mind, honest, truthful, respected, and well known;
- G. The Association will pay the annual Membership Dues of 2 troy ounces of silver (Buffaloes/Sunshine/Bullion rounds of 99.9% or higher) for the people who apply to be Private Members who are members of the Association or are renewing their Private Membership;
- H. The PDA will provide commission based compensation to the Coordinators for transactions that go through their control;
- I. The Prairie Freedom Fund will provide the Association with a promotional fee related to certain transactions done by members of the Association;
- J. The PDA has the right to reject any appointed or nominated individual that is deemed not suitable, or does not pass vetting;
- K. The PDA will require all Private Members to be members of the local Association unless they specifically have a reason to not at which point the PDA will connect the party to the next closest group;
- L. The Association is allowed to collect Membership Dues to cover the dues required in the PDA plus any other costs the Association deems needed to serve the member;
- M. The PDA policies and agreements will take precedence in operational direction;
- N. Any conflict between the parties will be determined by the PDA agreement and if required the PDA Dispute Resolution Committee;
- O. This agreement may be terminated by either party with sixty (60) days notice to the other party in writing.

These provisions are agreed to by the Association and the PDA on the date listed above,
