1. Policy Statement

Hovedstad Lodge will award scholarships for college, vocational or trade school education to deserving students for the furtherance of their education.

2. Procedures

- a) The Board will appoint a three-person Scholarship Committee annually to oversee the scholarship process.
- b) The Board will designate the maximum amount of scholarship money to be awarded each year.
- c) The Scholarship Committee will market and process the applications. The Committee will determine the precise amount to award each recipient.
- d) Scholarship applications will be accepted from January 1st through late April each year. Applications received after the deadline date will not be considered.
- e) The recipient may be:
 - I. A Hovedstad Lodge member in good standing.
 - II. Member of the immediate family of a Lodge member in good standing.
 - i. Children or grandchildren (biological, adopted, or stepchildren)
- f) The recipient or sponsor must be an active Lodge participant during at least three (3) of the past five (5) years.
- g) The recipient's home of record must be in the State of Washington.
- h) The scholarships will be paid to the school designated by the applicant. The funds must be used during the academic year for which the scholarship has been awarded. Scholarships not used are required to be returned.
- i) The scholarship will be awarded only if a qualified application is received.

Information for Applicants

1. Scholarship applications will be accepted from January 1st through April 30th of each year. Applications received after April 30th will not be considered.
2. The recipient may be:
 - a. A Hovedstad Lodge member in good standing.
 - b. Member of the immediate family of a Lodge member in good standing.
 - i. Children and grandchildren (biological, adopted, or stepchildren)
3. The recipient or sponsor must be an active Lodge participant during at least three (3) of the past five (5) years.
4. The recipient's home of record must be in the State of Washington.
5. The Committee will determine the precise amount to award each recipient.
6. Scholarships will be awarded during the month of May. Each applicant and their sponsor will receive a letter from the Scholarship Committee. The recipients then need to provide the scholarship committee with the name and address of the school and provide their student ID number and proof of enrollment.
7. The scholarship will be paid directly to the school.
8. Recipients will be invited to visit Hovedstad Lodge to talk about their education and career goals.
