It wasn't that the fishing was tough at DVL in September, there were many fish caught, however the fish that you could bring to the scale were few and far between.

John Demonet weighed in four bass, but one was the tournament BIG FISH of 4.85 lbs. John used the Bubba Shot rig with a Senko and a Neko Rig to bring a total of four bass weighing 13.83 pounds for the win.

Ken Cox had the only limit from DVL tipping the scale to 10.15 pounds to finish in 2nd Place. Ken used a Neko Fat worm and a Senko

to wade through the many short fish for his 5 keepers.

Rick Rakins' lucky number is three. He caught a fish that weighed 3.38 pounds for a 3rd place finish. Rick caught plenty of fish on a drop shot MM III, which is a good bait to throw at DVL, but only one made it to the scale.

Andy Willoughby was the odd man out, as far as bait choice is concerned, he caught his keeper on an Ika, fishing down a point in about 15 feet of water to take the 4th spot with 3.23 pounds.

Keith Beever rounded

out the top five catching his only keeper fish with a drop shot Senko that weighed 1.72 pounds

Mark Quaternik brought one fish to the scale for 1.41 pounds, and Mike Byrum weighed in a 1.11 pounder for his efforts of the day.

The results for DVL were seven OCBC members weighing in 14 bass, weighing 34.83 pounds.

Hopefully El Cap will cooperate a little better on October 1, 2022.

Byrum Clinches the AOY with Win at El Cap

Mike Byrum! Sometimes when an angler does well , he states that he found a *“honey hole”*, but in Mikes’ case, he found a *“honey rock”*, nestled way back up the lake that produced the necessary fish for the win. This win also propelled Mike to the top spot in the AOY race, nudging past Scott Stewart by a mere 4 points. One of only three limits weighed in, Mikes’ limit contained the BIG FISH of the tournament weighing in at 4.47 pounds and a total five fish weight of 14.38 pound, effectively clinching the win at El Cap and the AOY race for 2017. The winner used only two baits to get his limit of El Cap bass, a Texas rigged watermelon/purple Brush Hog and a green pumpkin/purple Brush Hog on a Shakeyhead jig. With two wins in the 2017 season and the AOY champion, Mike will be competing in the TOC in November. **Congratulations**
