Keith Beever fished a crankbait and a Senko in front of rocky points to put a limit in the boat for 10.74 pounds, taking the Second Place trophy.

Third Place went to Bud Maes, with a five fish limit totaling 10.13

pounds. Unfortunately I wasn't able to find out how he caught his fish.

Doug Bullard secured the Fourth spot with only three fish, but they were nice ones. Fishing right on the bank, he caught one on an MMIII Robo worm, and the other two on a Wacky rigged green pumpkin/black flake worm. Doug's fish tipped the scale to 8.18 pounds.

Nailing down Fifth Place with only two fish was Steve Weiner. Again I have no information on how he caught his fish, however in his bag was the BIG FISH of the tournament weighing a respectable

3.95 pounds, giving him a total of 6.30 pounds for the tournament.

A guest, Dave Pisarski caught the second biggest bass of the tournament, weighing 3.91 pounds, and was lucky enough to get into the BIG FISH pot, while Steve didn't, so he won the BIG FISH pot. Combined, the club caught 30 bass weighing 63.59 pounds, with a lot of three pounders hitting the scale.
