The Havasu TOC Belongs to Jonathan Demonet

Havasu didn't treat the Orange County Bass Club TOC with much hospitality. Unfortunately only six members that qualified for the TOC were able to make the event, and those that went found it tough fishing and only one limit was weighed in by Richard Ragland.

Jonathan has a good history with Havasu, and used it well to catch fish on a swimbait and drop shotting the deep habitat cages that were placed in Havasu. Jonathan brought six fish to the scale in the two day event, weighing 16.94 pounds to take the TOC win.

Richard Ragland, as I said before, brought the only limit to the scale on day one for 9.12 pounds, and

followed up on day two with two fish for 3.86 pounds, making his total for Second Place 12.98 pounds.

The TOC should thank Candy for hurting her knee on day one because John didn't get to fish on day two and still finished in Third Place, and had the BIG FISH of the tournament. John fished a Chatterbait in front of the tules, catching three fish totaling 10.84 pounds, the big fish weighing 4.61 pounds.

Shane Rubin said the bite was tough for him, but he did weigh five fish over the two days totaling 6.22 pounds and finished in Fourth Place. Shane's baits of choice were a Jerkbait and the Ika.

Keith Beever had a tough first day at Havasu, but caught three fish on the second day for 4.64 pounds fishing a spinnerbait and a jerkbait in front of the river tules.

The AOY champion Chris Rhoden really struggled, catching one fish on a crankbait across a rocky point on beautiful Lake Havasu.

Well, that wraps up a very strange 2020 fishing season for the OCBC, but not too bad considering the restrictions of the year. The club weighed in 612 fish for a total weight of 1461.37 pounds, and crowned an AOY Champ that didn't finish in the top three places of any tournament of the year and still won AOY.
