PARENT AND CHILD COMMITMENT AGREEMENT

Keep for Your Records

The following is a summary of the rules and regulations presented by the Bronx Buccaneer Youth Program.

- Punctuality and attendance to practice/games is crucial. Pattern of lateness and/or unexcused absences may result in the player being penalized by sitting out of game or other penalties as seen fit by the staff.
- Attendance is taken at every practice and all games and is very important.
- Practice uniform is to be worn to all practices. If practice uniform is not available, player is to wear white top/tees and black bottoms (shorts or sweatpants) or any Buccs apparel until the distributed practice uniform is available. Any other team apparel will not be allowed.
- Abusive, violent, or vulgar acts, behaviors and/or language by Buccaneers parents, players, and staff towards opposing team members (coaches/player), spectators, referees, officials, or any members of the Bronx Buccaneers program (parents, players, and staff) on any field or at any practice/games is not permitted and will result in a form of discipline suitable for the infraction.
- We encourage a positive, fun, and safe environment for all. Bullying is not tolerated and will be grounds for immediate suspension or discharge.
- We promote a drug and alcohol-free program. Smoking or consumption of alcohol or any illegal substances on any field or at practices/games **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**.
- Any player, staff, volunteer, or parent caught under the influence will be asked to leave. This behavior threatens our permit and may result in grounds for formal discharging of player from the program.
- Players are expected to respect all staff, parents, volunteers, and other player's personal property. Theft is not tolerated and may be grounds for suspension and/or discharge with no refund of any fees already paid.
- Players are expected to fully participate in all drills, practices and games as required.
- Players are discouraged from wearing jewelry or bringing any valuables, large amounts of cash, electronics and/or handheld game devices to any practices, games, or events. We are not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged items your child brings to the program. Staff are not responsible for safeguarding any personal items.
- All concerns and issues with Buccs staff should be brought to Tasha Andrews or Leslie Alvira
- Remember this is a youth program. Although it is competitive and exciting, we must keep in mind that it is our children who are playing the game, let's remember to constantly encourage and support them.
- Respect to your child, other parents/family members and staff must be shown at all times.

Notices and Suggestions and Reminders

- On very hot days you may want to send your player to practice with a frozen bottle of water.
- On rainy days, please send your child with a plastic garbage bag to keep their belongings dry, also a change of clothes in case their uniform gets wet, especially socks is suggested.
- For the cold weather, consider getting your player hand warmer pouches, and thermals (black) to be worn under their uniforms.
- We practice in all weather conditions because games may be held in all weather conditions. Practice or games will only be cancelled for extreme weather conditions. You will be alerted if practice or a game is cancelled.
- If your child is traveling on their own via foot or public transportation, please do not allow them to travel in crocks or any slippers. They should be wearing sneakers in the event a situation arises, and they need to move quickly.
- Please remind your player to secure their phones and all belongings including footwear in their bags when they arrive to practice/games and to keep their bags closed at all times. We are not responsible for lost items.
- We suggest you remove all jewelry to include necklaces, earrings and bracelets. They may become loose during practice or games and get lost.
- Parents need to make every effort to arrive on time to pick-up your child either from practice, games or events.
