## ~~~ Drainage Issue Update ~~~

Several of our neighbors have volunteered and formed a committee to provide transparency to the Stone Meadow community. The committee will help to assist with the process and to explore potential funding from the county as well as the township. A portion of the project also relies on the county taking care of their responsibilities outside of our subdivision, which includes the drainage waterways along Maybee Rd.

Priority-1 project is excessive flooding of the Spring Meadow Ct. cul-de-sac along with storm water runoff to Gemini landing. We are hopeful that this project will be started and completed as soon as possible in 2026. You can check our webpage for a list of the seven priorities and the initial budgets to be confirmed by competitive subcontractors.

It has been determined that an assessment would be the best way to fund Priority-1.
