Saving Our Trees

We had 2 tree companies advise us to make residents aware of what could turn into issues later.

Many residents have applied too much mulch around their trees. If it's not the proper depth it will do more harm than good. The recommended mulch thickness is between 2-4 inches with a few empty inches between the mulch and the trunk. Higher mulch will rot the trunk, suffocate the tree, and kill it.

This is also the recommendation of The Arbor Day foundation.
