A tenant-determined, peer-to-peer supported improvement program for unhoused, homeless, "couch-surfing" and housing insecure individuals and families who have had difficulty getting or keeping rental housing in Story County but want to develop skills and strategies to become a successful tenant in stable, sustainable housing.

## Headed2Home is for people who can't get approved for rental housing due to

- Using a rental assistance (Section 8) voucher
- Rent would be more than 30% of income
- Flight from domestic abuse or violence
- No verifiable source(s) of income
- Frequent job or address changes
- A past eviction or foreclosure
- No or negative rental history
- No or negative credit history
- A criminal record
- Other (you tell us)



### 710 Kellogg Avenue in Ames

\$875 1-bedroom, Apt. 5 – 367 sq. ft. Holds 2 adults & one child OR 1 adult & 2 children Move-in Aug. 1

Square footage shown does not include kitchen and bathroom.

**Month-to-month** leases – a **maximum of 12 months** in Headed2Home program. **No application fee. Household's monthly rent payments** are 30% of household income. We define a **household** as individuals related by birth, marriage, lowa definition of common-law marriage or legal decree. Otherwise, each tenant's rent is determined separately.

**Security deposit is two (2) month's rent, due at lease signing.** Half of security deposit must be paid by tenants, service agency, or private third party. The other half may be payable for qualified applicants from the limited Home Allies/SCHT revolving security deposit fund. **Applicants for security deposit assistance must complete a one-page supplemental application.** 

**First month's rent also due at signing**. Rent subsidies provided by Home Allies' grants and donors are applicable in months two through twelve, if the lease is continued from month to month.

Previous applicants must complete and submit a new application.

**Multi-level** building with stairs. **No elevators, lifts or ramps**, and narrow interior doorways; building is not wheelchair accessible.

Hour-long interviews will be scheduled 10 AM to 5 PM July 25 and 26 via Zoom or in person at 710 Kellogg. Applicants will be ranked according to need, potential for progress in the program, and past challenges. Successful applicants will be notified on or before noon on July 29. Building is locked 24/7. Current tenants will not allow applicants entrance or to remain on the premises unless they have an appointment with the manager.

\*Living at 710 Kellogg Avenue. requires the head of household, and possibly others living in the unit, to participate in the Headed2Home rental program, which is organized. facilitated and monitored by board members and volunteers of Home Allies, Inc. Home Allies only offers targeted conversation and information with the tenant to help him/her identify past counter-productive financial and housing-related beliefs and actions, and develop skills and strategies expected to produce more positive results for the tenant in the future. Home Allies does not offer physical, medical, psychological or behavioral therapy. Home Allies does not offer assistance obtaining 'tools' that the tenant might need to enact skills or exercise strategies such as acquiring a photo ID, but will provide the tenant with referrals to such agencies and groups that do.

Rent subsidies from Home Allies are funded by American Rescue Plan's grant to Story County, Story County Housing Trust, and private donations. Agencies providing emergency housing, rapid-rehousing, permanent supportive housing or other rent support to Headed2Home tenants are expected to allocate the same amount in deposits, fees and rent subsidies to Home Allies, Inc. as they would to a private or for-profit landlord agreeing to rent to the tenant.

#### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Head of Household or Co-Head of Household:
  - o 6 months living in Story County OR 1 year working in Story County while living in a contiguous county
  - Membership in one of these priority population groups:
    - + Parent(s) of minor children

- + Survivors of domestic abuse or violence
- + Substance abusers sober 30 days or more
- + Offender(s) with non-violent criminal record(s)
- + Displaced worker(s) enrolled in a post-secondary trade program
- + US Military and Iowa National Guard veteran + Person with non-debilitating disability
  - + Young adults transitioning out of foster care
- All 18 and older in household:
  - o Must become employed or volunteer, and remain so, at least 15 hours/ week.
  - o Household income must ≤ 30% of Ames Area Median Income (AMI).
  - o Students attending a post-secondary academic program must be a member of two priority groups.
  - Household income may be ≤50% AMI if Head of Household is a member of two or more priority groups.
