She thoroughly enjoys teaching rug hooking, applique and Russian punch needle.

Kathy loves to teach primitives and antique reproductions as well as geometrics, Orientals, and florals. She likes to use various mix cuts in the same pattern. She strives to help each student to create the rug they envisioned. Kathy has a small lesson planned for each day of class to cover many rug hooking topics as well as any topics that her students request.

### **Caroline Twigg**

Caroline started rug hooking in late 2005 when a local library offered a free rug hooking class. She quickly found she loved primitive colors, patterns, and textures. As her passion grew for rug hooking, she began to study under teachers such as Barb Carroll, Cynthia Norwood, and Jayne Hester.

In 2011 she opened her studio, Eagles Nest Woolens. She now has over 100 patterns on her website, www.eaglesnestwoolens.com. She has been traveling and teaching the art of rug hooking since 2016.

Her class focus will be primitive patterns, colors, and cuts utilizing wider cut texture wools to achieve the feel of old rugs. Keep in mind primitive colors do not mean a colorless pallet. If you look at the back of an antique rug, most start life with brighter colors and have worn to the old dusty colors we all love. We will focus on the dusty and worn color pallet in class with splashes of bolder colors when necessary.

During class, she will discuss ways to enhance the look and texture of your rug. She will also try to eliminate some of your fears and doubts about your color planning skills.

Caroline and her husband, Ron, live in Western Maryland. She's filled her home with new and old hooked rugs. She's fascinated by the warmth and character of antique rugs.
