

How to Set up an IRS Online Account

To set up an IRS online account, follow these steps:

1. Visit the [IRS online account](#) page.
2. Select “Create an account” with [ID.me](#).
3. Enter your email address.
4. Check your email for a message from ID.me and confirm your email by clicking the link provided.
5. Set up multi-factor authentication for added security.

Once your account is set up, you can access your individual account information, including your balance, payments, tax records, and more. Here are some features available through your online account:

- **View Tax Records:** Access key data from your most recently filed tax return, including your adjusted gross income and view transcripts.
- **View Notices:** Digital copies of certain notices from the IRS.
- **Economic Impact Payments:** Information about your stimulus payments.
- **Child Tax Credit:** Details about advance Child Tax Credit payments.
- **Make Payments:** Pay from your bank account, debit/credit card, or digital wallet.
- **Payment History:** View 5 years of payment history, including estimated tax payments.
- **Payment Plans:** Learn about payment plan options and apply for a new payment plan.
- **Communication Preferences:** Go paperless for certain notices and receive email notifications for account activity.
