

## **Cascade Dance Academy's Covid-19 plan and policies 2021/22**

-We will be keeping both of our exterior doors open as much as weather permits, as well as our interior studio doors to increase ventilation throughout the building.

-Parents will not be allowed in wait or watch in the lobby. They will only be allowed in the building if they have a question for the office or need to make a purchase. Exceptions can be made for very young dancers needing assistance or reassurance from their grownup.

-We will continue to follow King County mandates and suggestions and ask everyone, regardless of vaccination status, to wear a mask in the building. Dancers under the age of 5 are strongly encouraged to wear a mask, but not required. This policy will be revisited frequently as our community situation and the vaccination status of our younger students changes.

-Staff will do their best to maintain social distancing in class – dancers will be given their own spot to stand in to keep everyone spread out. In the event that we do have to make contact (a young dancer falls down, or needs assistance) we will immediately sanitize both parties afterwards.

-Dancers will be released from the classroom a few minutes early so that they can have their shoes changed and be ready to walk out the door at the end of their class time. This is to minimize overlap in the lobby and stairwell between class groups.
