

We have added classes in recent months and are already using every part of the new building the Lord has allowed us to complete. The nursery program serves infants through children up to age 4. Children ages 5-11 are served through King's Kids and Children's Church, and our youth group is for those 12 years old through senior high.

We are excited to have Scott and Diana Quiroz serving as our youth directors. The Youth meet on Wednesday at 6:30 p.m., for Sunday School at 9 a.m., and at 10 a.m. for Sunday worship. They also have monthly gatherings, such as going sightseeing or having a cookout.

Scott and Diana's vision for the youth is for them to know Jesus Christ, as well as what He has done for them and for all of us. They are teaching them how the church/body of Christ began and how important it is for us in our everyday lives. They desire to be godly mentors for the youth, the future leaders of the church.
